A quorum was not present. The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm.

NOPD Report:

Jim Olsen reported on the crime statistics and trends for April. There were 39 crimes reported this year compared to 47 in April of last year. There were 1,492 calls for service, 42 traffic warnings, 131 residential checks, 673 business checks and four pedestrian checks this April. Nine misdemeanor arrests were made by MCSD officers.

MCSD Officers Reports

Jim Olsen advised those present that 2017 Tier 1 reports are due 5/15/18.

Financial Report:

Jim Olsen reported that there was approximately \$945,000 cash on hand at the end of April. Since then, over \$100,000 has been spent on MCSD officers' payroll.

Website:

Tung Ly reported that all problems with the website have been remedied and it is running as it should now.

Status of Vehicles:

Jim Olsen gave a report updating the status of the fleet. One of the units had to have brakes repaired and was in the shop. Unit 1408 was involved in a minor accident and is being repaired. The newest vehicle is now in service.


Discussion of Parcel Fee adjustments 2019 Statute renewal –

Discussion was had as to the need to have the information ready for the 2019 budget by the end of July. The Board will attempt to adjust the commercial property assessments up and the residential assessments down.
