Mr. Roesel and Ms. Lynn Dupont advised the Board on the 2020 update of Urban Area geographic boundaries and population figures recently promulgated by the US Census. They presented comparative changes from the 2010 geography and 2020 geography for all areas of the region, including the north shore urban areas in St. Tammany and Tangipahoa parishes. They further called attention to what RPC Staff believes to be an apparent discrepancy in the 2020 update wherein the area of the south shore upriver from the Bonnet Carre spillway in St. Charles Parish, including St.

John the Baptist Parish, was excluded from the New Orleans urban area in the 2020 census and reconfigured with the communities of Lutcher and Grammercy in St. James Parish.
