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1 (The Meeting was called to order and
2 proceeded as follows:)

3 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

4 Meeting of the Board of
5 Certification and Training for Solid Waste
6 Management Operators will come to order.
7 Meeting in Shreveport, October 25, 2016,
8 1:00 p.m.

9 Ms. Bordelon, could we have the roll
10 call, please?

11 **MS. BORDELON:**

12 Sure. Troy Barber.

13 **MR. BARBER:**

14 Here.

15 **MS. BORDELON:**

16 Henry LaGrange.

17 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

18 Present.

19 **MS. BORDELON:**

20 Jason Creil.

21 **MR. CREIL:**

22 Here.

23 **MS. BORDELON:**

24 John Fourrier.

25 **MR. FOURRIER:**

1 Here.

2 **MS. BORDELON:**

3 Bubba Wynn.

4 **MR. WYNN:**

5 Here.

6 **MS. BORDELON:**

7 Fred Williams.

8 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

9 Here.

10 **MS. BORDELON:**

11 Connie Henry.

12 **MS. HENRY:**

13 Here.

14 **MS. BORDELON:**

15 Mia Townsel, Lindsey Turtle. Gary
16 Bonvillain.

17 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

18 Here. Okay. We do have a quorum.
19 Review of the July 19, 2016 minutes: Ms.
20 Bordelon sent everybody a copy of it in
21 email. Anybody have any corrections to
22 those minutes?

23 Do we hear a motion to approve the
24 minutes?

25 **MR. BARBER:**

1 So moved.

2 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

3 Moved by Mr. Barber.

4 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

5 Second.

6 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

7 Seconded by Mr. Williams that we
8 approve the minutes as sent out for the
9 July 19th meeting. Any objection to the
10 motion? Hearing none, the motion passes.

11 Consideration of Operator
12 Certifications: The first application,
13 Tyler Broussard, Landfill Level B,
14 Jefferson Davis Landfill.

15 **MR. BARBER:**

16 And I don't know what, I'm confused
17 by this one. On Page 2, Number 3 at the
18 top. Said he had a conditional that was
19 issued in July of 2017. Do you know when
20 it was issued?

21 **MS. BORDELON:**

22 It was issued July of 2016.

23 **MR. BARBER:**

24 2016. And is this a --

25 **MS. BORDELON:**

1 Okay. Says he's requesting for
2 regular certification. What they had asked
3 was that had he not pass the test today, he
4 wanted to extend his conditional. But he
5 did pass the test today, so we'd like to
6 review it for a regular certification.

7 **MR. BARBER:**

8 Well, am I missing something? It
9 looks like he went to work here.

10 **MS. BORDELON:**

11 He'll have one year in February, and
12 it's all the heavy equipment operator work
13 to make up for the other -

14 **MR. BARBER:**

15 Not as a supervisor?

16 **MS. BORDELON:**

17 Yes.

18 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

19 Well, it says he supervised these
20 people down here, somewhere.

21 **MS. BORDELON:**

22 Yeah. Two heavy equipment
23 operators. And I did mention today that he
24 would make his one full year at the
25 Landfill.

1 **MR. BARBER:**

2 I mean, I'm not disputing that he
3 was one of the supervisors. But I'm
4 looking at the title of his position. It
5 says, heavy equipment operator at GPS
6 Operator. That does not say supervisor.

7 **MS. BORDELON:**

8 No. It says "name and titles of
9 employees supervised."

10 **MR. BARBER:**

11 Well, I know that. But the one that
12 -

13 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

14 He's looking at his title of his
15 position.

16 **MR. BARBER:**

17 Doesn't reference any type of
18 management.

19 **MR. FOURRIER:**

20 Well, he still doesn't have but one
21 year. You've got one year as a "B" and two
22 in construction. He does have the one year
23 in "B", so we can give him a regular
24 anyway.

25 **MS. BORDELON:**

1 Right. And that's what I was going
2 to say. I mentioned he would have the one
3 year until February. And then he was okay
4 with holding off officially until February.

5 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

6 Okay. Would you like to make a
7 motion that he submit detailed information
8 about his construction experience?

9 **MR. BARBER:**

10 I would.

11 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

12 Okay. Is there a second to the
13 motion?

14 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

15 I second it.

16 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

17 Seconded by Mr. LaGrange.

18 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

19 But to clarify, his construction
20 experience and specifically, his
21 supervisory capacity.

22 **MR. FOURRIER:**

23 Are we looking at extend his
24 conditional on that?

25 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

1 That'll be a different motion.
2 Well, we can put him in with the
3 conditional extension request.

4 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

5 And I think if he submits that in
6 time, we can take that up Friday. We'll be
7 setting out meeting February.

8 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

9 Right. Take it at the December
10 meeting.

11 **MS. BORDELON:**

12 Well, let see. Cause he doesn't
13 expire until January. This conditional
14 doesn't expire until January.

15 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

16 Okay. So we will take up the
17 extension in the December meeting.

18 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

19 If we receive the information, we
20 can potentially approve those.

21 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

22 Well, actually, you're still going
23 to have to extend the gap.

24 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

25 Because of the gap, yeah.

1 **MS. BORDELON:**

2 Well, no. Because he said he was
3 okay between January and February not
4 having certifications. To issue a regular,
5 start in February 12th.

6 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

7 He was okay that his conditional
8 would expire.

9 **MS. BORDELON:**

10 For one month.

11 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

12 Okay. Do we have motion to request
13 additional information from Mr. Broussard
14 concerning his supervisory experience in
15 construction?

16 **MR. BARBER:**

17 Motion.

18 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

19 Second.

20 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

21 And we have a second by Mr.
22 LaGrange. Any objection to the motion?

23 **MS. BORDELON:**

24 What specifically are you-all asking
25 for?

1 **MR. BARBER:**

2 To clarify his supervisory position.

3 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

4 The regulation requirements the
5 construction experience, plus he had
6 supervisory capacity. And we want a little
7 bit more verification on that. Because his
8 title is saying he is a heavy equipment
9 operator. Then it said that he's a
10 supervisor.

11 **MR. BARBER:**

12 I think we would like for him to
13 give us a little more detail.

14 **MR. WYNN:**

15 Now, if he would've said he was a
16 laid operator. That would've been a
17 supervisory position.

18 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

19 Yeah. It's just, you know, it's
20 just kind of ambiguous.

21 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

22 A lot of times in descriptive work
23 they would say, you know, "instruct the
24 other operators on what they need to do.
25 Setup the elevations or whatever, and

1 oversee that."

2 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

3 Right. And the description to the work in
4 detail doesn't say anything about actually
5 supervising anybody. That he has three
6 people that he supervise. So it's a little
7 ambiguous.

8 Okay. Any objection to the motion?
9 Hearing none, the motion passes.

10 Next up: Nature Fryka. We get this
11 one at every meeting. C&D, Level B. She's
12 been a conditional since 2014. And I think
13 she finally has the amount of years to get
14 a regular certification. Any problems with
15 that application?

16 Next: Kevin Henderson, Landfill,
17 Level B, Desoto Parish-Mundy Landfill.
18 Okay, no questions for that one.

19 Next: Wilbert Kelly Jr, Incinerator,
20 Level A, City of Lake Charles. Okay, no
21 questions on that one.

22 Next: Delisa Martin, Landfill, Level
23 B, Desoto Parish-Mundy Landfill.

24 **MR. BARBER:**

25 This one, he won't make the

1 requirements or the experience until
2 3/23/17. We'll actually meet at least one
3 more time before then.

4 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

5 We'll meet in December.

6 **MR. BARBER:**

7 I mean, we can do it pending that
8 date.

9 **MS. BORDELON:**

10 I'd rather you-all do it pending
11 that date. That way we don't have to look
12 at it again.

13 **MR. BARBER:**

14 Okay. Well, then I'll offer a
15 motion for it.

16 **MS. BORDELON:**

17 Cause I did let her know she
18 wouldn't be here two years until March.

19 **MR. BARBER:**

20 I'll offer a motion that we approve
21 this application, pending the date of
22 3/23/17 to be his or her eligibility.

23 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

24 Okay. A motion by Mr. Barber. Is
25 there a second?

1 **MR. WYNN:**

2 Second.

3 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

4 Seconded by Mr. Wynn that we approve
5 Delisa Martin's application effective March
6 23, 2017. Any objection to the motion?
7 Okay, hearing none, the motion passes.

8 Next: Jenny Parker, Landfill, Level
9 A. Waste Connections. She has been
10 previously certified for lack of education.

11 **MR. WYNN:**

12 But now, she did fail the test.

13 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

14 Yeah. But this is going to approve
15 in the application.

16 Okay. Next: Darryl Richey, C&D,
17 Level B. Moss Bluff Disposal.

18 Edna Stevenson, Landfill, Level B.
19 Desoto Parish-Mundy Landfill.

20 **MR. BARBER:**

21 This one is the same thing, but it's
22 6/15/17 to meet eligibility of experience.

23 **MR. WYNN:**

24 Well, since they don't have to have
25 a conditional, I think this application

1 needs to be brought up at a later date. I
2 make that a motion.

3 **MR. BARBER:**

4 Second.

5 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

6 Okay. Motion by Mr. Wynn. Second
7 by Mr. Barber that this application be
8 tabled for a later date. Any objection to
9 the motion?

10 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

11 Discussion. What's the difference
12 in this one and the previous one that
13 disapproves to be tabled on a later date?

14 **MS. BORDELON:**

15 There's not. If we're going to do
16 that, we might as well wait on both of
17 them.

18 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

19 I was just curious.

20 **MR. BARBER:**

21 Well, that one is just a little
22 further away. That's the only thing
23 different that I've seen. Three months
24 further away.

25 **MR. WYNN:**

1 Well, and plus you got another board
2 meeting in March. Two more board meetings.

3 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

4 Okay. I just wanted to ask the
5 question.

6 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

7 Okay. Any other discussion?

8 **MS. HENRY:**

9 So are we going back to change the
10 other one?

11 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

12 Not unless somebody wants to make a
13 motion.

14 **MR. WYNN:**

15 Okay. What would be easier for you?
16 For them both to wait?

17 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

18 I think she commented earlier, that
19 she would rather do them now then have to
20 review them again. That's what she said
21 earlier.

22 **MS. BORDELON:**

23 Yeah. Cause if we wait till we meet
24 in -- When we meet in July, then all we
25 have to do is approve the issuance of her

1 certification at that time. We won't have
2 to review the application again.

3 **MR. WYNN:**

4 All right. Can I rescind my motion?

5 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

6 You sure can.

7 **MR. WYNN:**

8 I'll rescind my motion. We'll go
9 ahead and take it now.

10 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

11 Okay. But we're going to need a
12 motion to approve it effective June 2017.

13 **MR. WYNN:**

14 I'll make that motion.

15 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

16 Second.

17 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

18 Okay. Motion by Mr. Wynn. Second
19 by Mr. Williams that Edna Stevenson's
20 application be approved effective in June
21 2017? Any further discussion? Any
22 objection to the motion? Okay. Hearing
23 none, the motion passes.

24 The next one: Brandon Steward,
25 Incinerator, Level A. City of Lake

1 Charles.

2 **MR. BARBER:**

3 And this one is basically the same
4 thing. This is an A level. Won't meet the
5 experience requirement until 2/2/17. I'll
6 offer a motion that we grant this one
7 pending that date of 2/2/17.

8 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

9 Second.

10 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

11 Okay. A motion by Mr. Barber.
12 Second by Mr. LaGrange that Brandon
13 Steward's application be accepted effective
14 2/2/17. Any discussions? Any objections
15 to the motion? Okay. Hearing none, the
16 motion passes.

17 Next: Willis Sudds, Sr., Landfill,
18 Level B. Desoto Parish-Mundy Landfill.
19 Landon Thompson, Landfill, Level B. Waste
20 Connections. Marques Williams, Landfill,
21 Level B. Republic Services-Woolworth Road
22 Landfill. Truet S. Wilson, Landfill, Level
23 B. Waste Connections.

24 Okay. So we need a motion to accept
25 the applications for Nature Fryka, C&D,

1 Level B. Kevin Henderson, Landfill, Level
2 B. Wilbert Kelly, Incinerator, Level A.
3 Jenny Parker, Landfill, Level A. Darryl
4 Richey, C&D, Level B. Wills Sudds, Sr.,
5 Landfill, Level B. Landon Thompson,
6 Landfill, Level B. Marques Williams,
7 Landfill, Level B. Truet Wilson, Landfill,
8 Level B.

9 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

10 So moved.

11 **MS. HENRY:**

12 Second.

13 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

14 Moved by Mr. Williams. Seconded by
15 Ms. Henry that we approve the above named
16 applications. Any discussion? Any
17 objection to the motion? Hearing none, the
18 motion passes.

19 Review Requests for Conditional
20 Certification Extensions. We have Gretchen
21 Tullier, Choctaw Road Landfill. She has
22 taken her test and passed, and has attended
23 class.

24 **MS. BORDELON:**

25 Correct.

1 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

2 Can I get a motion to extend the
3 request for two years?

4 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

5 So moved.

6 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

7 Okay. Moved by Mr. LaGrange.

8 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

9 Second.

10 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

11 Second by Mr. Williams that Gretchen
12 Tullier's conditional be extended for
13 another six months. Any objection to the
14 motion? And hearing none, the motion
15 passes.

16 Frank Goetz, Landfill, Level A.

17 **MR. BARBER:**

18 It looks to me like this guy, and it
19 says that he's asking for a third
20 extension. But it looks to me like he
21 meets the requirement. Like the 27th,
22 he'll have two years. Plus, if you look
23 down here, he's got supervisory experience
24 in heavy equipment operator. I don't know
25 anything about his application.

1 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

2 That does not apply for Level A.
3 Only applies for Levels B and C. It
4 requires for trucking experience.

5 **MR. BARBER:**

6 And I did have another question that
7 may not be relevant, but about midways of
8 the application where it's got \$100 for
9 recertification and \$200 for
10 recertification. He checked that and
11 apparently paid \$200.

12 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

13 Looking at this date, I would say
14 that this one expires in September.

15 **MS. BORDELON:**

16 Right. So he -

17 **MR. BARBER:**

18 So he ended up being late because he
19 was late with his extension, okay. All
20 right. So we need a motion on that?

21 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

22 We need a motion.

23 **MR. BARBER:**

24 I'll offer a motion that we grant
25 him his third extension.

1 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

2 Okay. Motion by Mr. Barber.

3 **MR. WYNN:**

4 Second.

5 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

6 Second by Mr. Wynn that the addition
7 certification for Frank Goetz for Level A
8 be extended an additional six months. Any
9 discussion? Any objection to the Motion?
10 Okay. Hearing none, the motion passes.

11 Okay. Requests for Conditional
12 Certificates. We have two from Cenla
13 Environmental. I think Ms. Bordelon has an
14 update for us on that.

15 **MS. BORDELON:**

16 The request from Justin Clark has
17 been withdrawn.

18 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

19 Okay. So all we're looking at is a
20 conditional request for Kasie Danielle
21 Lemoine, which would be Level A,
22 Incinerator. And she is replacing Ann
23 Wilson. There is no termination date on
24 Ann Wilson. Have you verified that?

25 **MS. BORDELON:**

1 I don't know the exact date, but
2 it's recent.

3 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

4 It's within?

5 **MS. BORDELON:**

6 Oh, yeah. The time line for them,
7 Jason, if you're not familiar with her
8 request, a conditional has to be done
9 within one year of its termination date.

10 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

11 Okay. Do I hear a motion?

12 **MR. WYNN:**

13 I'll make a motion.

14 **MR. BARBER:**

15 Second.

16 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

17 Motion by Mr. Wynn. Second by Mr.
18 Barber that we approve the conditional
19 application for Kasie Lemoine. Any
20 objection to the motion? Hearing none, the
21 motion passes.

22 Okay. Then we have a request from
23 Debra Nettles, C&D, Level B. Schamerhorn
24 C&D. And she is replacing a regular
25 certified operator.

1 **MS. BORDELON:**

2 Joshua Sturgeon, who was terminated
3 on 5/8/16.

4 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

5 Do I hear a motion?

6 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

7 Move the motion.

8 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

9 Moved by Mr. LaGrange.

10 **MR. WYNN:**

11 Second.

12 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

13 Seconded by Mr. Wynn that we grant
14 the conditional certification for Debra
15 Nettles for C&D, Level B. Any objection to
16 the motion? Hearing none, the motion
17 passes.

18 Review of Applications for
19 Recertification. Okay. You have on the
20 second sheet: Marshall Bancroft, Landfill,
21 Level A. Pete Chreene, Landfill, Level A.
22 Alex Edwards, Landfill, Level B. Rachel
23 Fox, Landfill, Level B. Susan Helmer,
24 Landfill, Level A. Tony LeBlanc, C&D,
25 Level B. Alex Papillion, Landfill, Level

1 B. Jimmy Shallow, Incinerator, Level A.
2 Harold Stutes, Landfill, Level B. Bridget
3 Tillman, Landfill, Level B. Jason
4 Williams, Landfill, Level B. Christopher
5 Wooton, Landfill, Level A.

6 And these have all obtained their 40
7 hours of training?

8 **MS. BORDELON:**

9 Yes.

10 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

11 Okay. Do I hear a motion?

12 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

13 What District is Mr. Wooton?

14 **MS. BORDELON:**

15 He's not for the facility currently.

16 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

17 All right.

18 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

19 I move, Mr. Chairman.

20 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

21 Okay. A motion by Mr. LaGrange.

22 **MR. FOURRIER:**

23 Second.

24 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

25 Second by Mr. Fourrier that the

1 above named applications for
2 recertification be approved. Any
3 discussion? Any objection to the motion?
4 Okay. Hearing none, the motion passes.

5 I have an incomplete recertification
6 application for Stanley Woodley, Landfill,
7 Level B, Desoto Parish. Has 30 hours and
8 he's supposed to be attending this session.

9 **MS. HENRY:**

10 He's here.

11 **MR. BORDELON:**

12 And he is here. Okay.

13 **MR. WYNN:**

14 When does his time expire?

15 **MS. BORDELON:**

16 When does he expire?

17 **MR. WYNN:**

18 Yeah.

19 **MS. BORDELON:**

20 November 5th.

21 **MR. WYNN:**

22 Okay. I make a motion.

23 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

24 Made a motion to approve his re-
25 certification upon completion of the

1 October seminar in Shreveport. Do I hear a
2 second?

3 **MR. BARBER:**

4 Second.

5 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

6 Seconded by Mr. Barber. Any
7 discussion? Any objection to the motion?
8 Okay. Hearing none, the motion passes.

9 Okay. Next we have the Issuance of
10 Operator Certificates. Ms. Bordelon would
11 you call the list, please?

12 **MS. BORDELON:**

13 Sure. Nature Fryka, C&D, Level B.
14 Davis Wooton, C&D, Level A. Wilbert Kelly,
15 Jr., Incinerator, Level A. Darryl Richey,
16 C&D, Level B. Willis Sudds, Landfill,
17 Level B. Landon Thompson, Landfill, Level
18 B. Marques Williams, Landfill, Level B.
19 Truet Wilson, Landfill, Level B.

20 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

21 Okay. Do I have a motion that we
22 issue those certificates?

23 **MR. FOURRIER:**

24 Motion.

25 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

1 Second.

2 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

3 Motion by Mr. Fourrier. Seconded by
4 Mr. Williams that we issue the above named
5 certificates. Any discussion? Any
6 objection to the motion? Okay. Hearing
7 none, the motion passes.

8 Okay. We have the committee
9 reports. The awards, Ms. Turtle. She's
10 not here. Testing, Mr. LaGrange.

11 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

12 Thank you. We had 17 tests and 14
13 passed.

14 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

15 Okay.

16 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

17 I'd like to thank Ms. Bordelon for
18 having that as usually as she always does.

19 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

20 Continuing education, Troy Barber.

21 **MR. BARBER:**

22 This is our last workshop of the
23 year and we had 59 in attendance today. So
24 this will conclude 2016 workshops.

25 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

1 Okay. Nominating, Mr. Williams.

2 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

3 Okay. Mr. Chairman, we have two
4 Board Members who are being re-appointed
5 for the second and third year of term. The
6 letters are in Mr. Don Brown's office, they
7 have not been signed yet. That's Gary
8 Bonvillain, Louisiana Solid Waste and Troy
9 Barber from LMA.

10 Also, we have a replacement for
11 Bubba Wynn who wouldn't normally be going
12 off, but the other letter has not been sign
13 as well. But the person that will be
14 replacing him is Danny Hilton, H-I-L-T-O-N,
15 of Jeff Davis Landfill.

16 **MS. BORDELON:**

17 I was going to say that was a name
18 that was not the nomination that was sent
19 in from the Policy Jury Association.

20 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

21 Okay. And that letter has been
22 drafted, but not signed as well.

23 **MS. BORDELON:**

24 Right. We just received the letter
25 on Friday.

1 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

2 So until we get that, Bubba, you're
3 still on. I guess it will be done for the
4 December meeting. But we have two that
5 will be re-appointed, and one being
6 replaced.

7 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

8 Okay. Other business. Review LSWA
9 agenda for CEU's for Lafayette Conference.
10 And we have with us Mr. Bill Mollere, who
11 is the Chapter of the LSWA - I mean,
12 President of the LSWA Chapter.

13 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

14 He's the Chapter.

15 **MR. MOLLERE:**

16 Thank you, Mr. Chairman. That's
17 M-O-L-L-E-R-E. Last year when I reviewed
18 the minutes, it had a really strange
19 spelling of my name.

20 I'd like to pass around a copy of
21 the opposed agenda. It is scheduled for
22 March 16th and 17th in Lafayette, which is
23 Thursday and Friday. And I ask that the
24 Board consider training 10 hours of
25 certification for solid waste.

1 You'll notice on there that we have
2 also a total five track being offered this
3 past year, and our industrial energy track
4 has some other topics that are relevant to
5 the solid waste track.

6 The UST has their own certification
7 program, and they have their own agenda
8 that works up, but we do not have it here.
9 And the Louisiana Environmental Health
10 Association has their own program they say
11 we'll be offering.

12 And we don't have a complete agenda
13 for them yet, but they're sort of
14 partnering with us. This would be, I think
15 the third year that they'll be doing that.
16 But we also will be offering more. It's at
17 least worth a try.

18 We have a Hearing Committee of about
19 22 people that get together beginning in
20 August. And they come together on several
21 different occasions and offer all these
22 topics. And also put together the
23 speakers, and to get this agenda for us,
24 and do a great deal of work and we're very
25 appreciative of that.

1 But we've been very successful by
2 using that particular method. And the
3 Hearing Committee is made of industry
4 people and governmental people. And these
5 people volunteer their time and their
6 efforts and come together and do this.

7 So Mr. Chairman, I would add that
8 such Board of Certification grant 10 hours
9 of certification to the solid waste
10 operators who attend and successfully
11 complete the conference.

12 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

13 Does anybody have any questions for
14 Mr. Mollere?

15 **MR. BARBER:**

16 No. I don't have a question, but I
17 do have a request. I know that there's
18 four or five members of this Board who's
19 own the LSWA Board and probably most of
20 you-all -- Probably all of you-all are very
21 aware of what's on this.

22 But the rest of us on the Board is
23 handed this and asked to look at it in a
24 couple of minutes. I would like to request
25 in the future that if we can get it a week

1 or two in advance by email.

2 **MR. MOLLERE:**

3 Sure.

4 **MR. BARBER:**

5 Suzanne has all our emails. So that
6 we can go over this and have kind of a
7 little time to look at it and think about
8 it, rather than just handing it to us. And
9 with that being said, I would like to make
10 a motion that we approve this agenda.

11 **MR. MOLLERE:**

12 Thank you, Mr. Barber. That's very
13 reasonable and yes, we can do that.

14 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

15 Okay. We have a motion by Mr.
16 Barber that we approve the agenda for 10
17 hours. Is there a second for the motion?

18 **MR. FOURRIER:**

19 Second.

20 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

21 Second by Mr. Fourrier. Any
22 discussion? Okay. Any opposition to the
23 motion? Okay. Hearing none, the motion
24 passes.

25 **MR. MOLLERE:**

1 Thank you, Mr. Chairman. And thank
2 you, Board. I look forward to have all of
3 you hopefully attend in Lafayette.
4 Starting on the Wednesday night, the 15th,
5 come in beach attire.

6 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

7 Okay. Next, we have election of
8 Chairman and Vice-Chairman. We'll go ahead
9 and do the election of Chairman first. The
10 floor is open.

11 **MR. BARBER:**

12 I elect John Bubba Wynn.

13 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

14 Second.

15 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

16 Mr. Chairman, I move that the
17 nomination be closed.

18 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

19 Okay. Is there a second to the
20 motion?

21 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

22 Second.

23 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

24 Okay. Moved by Mr. Williams.
25 Second by Mr. LaGrange. That the

1 nomination be closed. We all need
2 nomination via myself. Any opposition to
3 the motion? Hearing none, the motion
4 passes.

5 Okay. The floors open for
6 nomination for Vice-Chairman.

7 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

8 Mr. Chairman, I nominate Beau
9 LaGrange.

10 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

11 Okay. Got a motion for Beau
12 LaGrange or a nomination for Beau LaGrange.

13 **MR. FOURRIER:**

14 Second.

15 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

16 Second by Mr. Fourrier. Any other
17 nominations?

18 **MR. BARBER:**

19 I move that the nomination be
20 closed.

21 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

22 Okay. A motion by Mr. Barber for
23 the nominations be closed.

24 **MS. HENRY:**

25 Second.

1 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

2 Motion by Mr. Barber. Second by Ms.
3 Henry that the nomination be closed. Any
4 objection to the motion? Okay. Hearing
5 none, the motion is approved. Mr. Beau
6 LaGrange is our new Vice-Chairman.

7 And Mr. LaGrange, as an award for
8 being selected as Vice-Chairman, we'll even
9 let you host the December meeting.

10 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

11 Was that a motion, Mr. Chairman?

12 **MS. HENRY:**

13 Sounds like it was a little demand.

14 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

15 And once again, we'd love to host
16 the next Board of Certification meeting
17 down in St. Mary Parish. The dates will be
18 the first Friday is the 2nd, and the
19 following Friday is the 9th; is that
20 correct? I won't be available on the 2nd,
21 but the 9th I would or the 16th.

22 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

23 The 9th is good.

24 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

25 Okay. Did I hear a motion that we

1 had scheduled the December meeting for 9:00
2 o'clock in Patterson, Louisiana -- I'm
3 sorry, December 9th.

4 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

5 Mr. Chairman, before you carry that
6 motion, is there any opposition to us doing
7 it on the 16th? Beau?

8 **MR. LaGRANGE:**

9 No. Like I said, I'm willing to do
10 it 9th or the 16th.

11 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

12 Would anybody else be opposed?
13 Anybody be oppose to the 16th?

14 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

15 Okay. I'm open for a motion for
16 either dates.

17 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

18 Well, I'd like to make a motion that
19 we meet on the 16th.

20 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

21 At 10:00 o'clock in Patterson.
22 Okay. Is there a second for the motion?

23 **MR. FOURRIER:**

24 I second it.

25 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

1 Okay. A motion by Mr. William.
2 seconded by Mr. Fourrier that the December
3 meeting be schedule for December 16th at
4 10:00 a.m. in Patterson. Any objection to
5 the motion? Okay. Hearing none, the
6 motion passes.

7 Okay. Public comments. The only
8 public we had here has already made his
9 comments. So do I hear a motion to
10 adjourn?

11 **MR. WYNN:**

12 Mr. Chairman, I did enjoy being on
13 the Board again this last term. And I just
14 want to tell everybody that I appreciate
15 what they have done on the Board, and I
16 believe that the Board has done very well.
17 Very good job.

18 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

19 Well, just remember that until we
20 get a signed letter from the secretary, you
21 are still on the Board.

22 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

23 Ms. Bordelon will let you know when
24 you are no longer officially on the Board.

25 **MR. WYNN:**

1 Well, that was my farewell. You
2 ain't getting it twice.

3 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

4 And Bubba, we've enjoyed having you
5 with us. And sorry to see that you have to
6 go. If you could just win an election, you
7 know, you wouldn't have to leave.

8 Okay. Now, do we have a motion to adjourn?

9 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

10 So moved.

11 **MR. BARBER:**

12 Second.

13 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

14 Moved by Mr. Williams. Seconded by
15 Mr. Barber. Any objections? Hearing none,
16 the motion passes.
