The Liquefied Petroleum Gas Commission held its regular meeting at 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, April 24, 2013 at the Hayden House, 61153 Hwy 445, Amite, Louisiana.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Mr. James Hopson, with the following members present:

The latest expenditure and revenue reports ending March 30, 2013 were reviewed.

The statistical reports for the period ending March 30, 2013 were reviewed.

The accounting total reports for March 2012 and March 2013 were reviewed.

Report of fires and accidents for March 2013 were reviewed.

The compliance audits for March 2013 were reviewed.
