**§533. Reporting Requirements for Changes in Operations**

A. OBD is to be notified immediately of any change which affects the tax exemption contract. This includes any changes in the ownership or operational name of a firm holding a tax exemption contract. A fee of \$250 shall be filed with a request for any contract amendment, including but not limited to, a change of ownership, change in name, or change in location. The board may consider restrictions or cancellation of a contract for cessation of the manufacturing operation, or retirement of any portion of the exempted equipment. Failure to report any material changes constitutes a breach of contract and, with approval by the board, shall result in restriction or termination.

The Folger Coffee Company submitted the below letter along with additional attachments on 1/13/23, requesting to appeal 6 ITEP Applications, denied by Orleans Parish local governmental entities, to the Board:

*Dear Board Members,*

*I would like to thank you, on behalf of The Folger Coffee Company (“Folger”), for the opportunity to bring Folger’s Louisiana Industrial Property Tax Exemption Program issues to your attention.*

*Folger has proudly done business in New Orleans for 63 years. The symbiotic relationship between Folger and New Orleans ultimately resulted in Folger’s consolidation of its nationwide manufacturing operations in New Orleans in 2010 following a recruitment effort by the State. As a part of that recruitment effort, the state entered into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement (“CEA”) with Folger that allowed it to qualify for the Industrial Property Tax Exemption Program (“ITEP”) through 2020. However, the local governing authorities took liberties to create new and additional rules that impacted our ITEP eligibility, and these new local rules directly conflict not only with the State’s commitment to Folger as memorialized in the CEA, but also the Board’s very own rules. As a result, Folger, despite meeting and significantly exceeding its new job creation, new payroll, and capital investment commitments under the CEA, had its ITEP applications denied for its investments from August 2017 through April 2020.*

*We are appealing six (6) ITEP applications that were unanimously approved by the Louisiana Board of Commerce & Industry (“C&I Board”), but failed to receive local support from the New Orleans City Council (“NOCC”), the Orleans Parish School Board (“OPSB”), and the Orleans Parish Sheriff. The ITEP Applications are noted as follows:*

Furthermore, the ordinance and resolution were discussed and utilized during the review of the ITEP applications, adversely impacting Folger’s ability to secure local support.*
