

**CERTIFICATION FOR MAY 2020
STATEWIDE CEMETERY RESPONSE TASK FORCE MEETING**

In accordance with La. Acts 2020, No. 302 and Executive Proclamation JBE 2021-79, this notice shall serve as a certification of the Statewide Cemetery Response Task Force's ("CRTF") inability to otherwise operate in accordance with the Louisiana Open Meetings Law as a result of the COVID-19 public health emergency. The CRTF will provide for attendance and quorum at its essential government meeting on May 27, 2020, via video conference. Pursuant to La. Acts 2020, No. 302, the Council must meet because:

- 1) Governor John Bel Edwards has continued the state of emergency due to a public health emergency covering the geographic area served by the CRTF and a gathering to facilitate this meeting pursuant to the Open Meetings Law would be detrimental to the health, safety, or welfare of the public.
- 2) Matters that, if they are delayed, will cause curtailment of vital public services or severe economic dislocation and hardship. Because the CRTF is currently in the midst of overseeing and managing cemetery response efforts resulting from Hurricanes Laura, Delta, and Zeta, its continued function during this pandemic is essential and, failing timely meeting, would result in the curtailment of vital public services or severe economic dislocation and hardship.

Considering the foregoing, and in accordance with La. Acts 2020, No. 302 and Executive Proclamation JBE 2021-79, the CRTF's meeting on Thursday, May 27, 2021, at 2:00 P.M. will be held via video conference and in a manner that allows for observation and input by members of the public, as set forth in the Notice posted on May 20, 2020.
