

Specifications for 3000006189 – Plumbing for various fish hatcheries at Department of Wildlife and Fisheries

Contract to provide equipment, tools, and labor to repair plumbing at the Wildlife and Fisheries hatcheries on an as-needed basis per hatchery call-out, per the attached specifications and contract notes, for a period of 12 (twelve) months from date of award.

Contractor must possess a valid license for municipal and public works construction, and have a minimum of 10 (ten) years' experience in excavation and repair of large underground piping and utilities, and repair of large above ground piping and associated components (valves, mechanical joints, etc.)

Important: In accordance with R.S. 37:2163A Contractors' license number in the appropriate classification(s) such as municipal and public works construction work must appear on the bid opening envelope on all projects in the amount of \$50,000 or more as enacted by house bill no.556 Act 725 2008 Legislature.

In accordance LA R.S. 37:2163, anyone objecting to the classification must send a certified letter to both the Louisiana State Licensing Board for Contractors and the Office of State Purchasing. The letter must be received no later than 10 (ten) working days prior to the day on which bids are to be opened.

Contract lines are set up to include all of the appropriate lines needed for each hatchery location.

Contract notes:

The following contract notes are in addition to the contract notes attachment, and are for further clarification. Please see contract notes attachment for other contract requirements.

All costs, including any travel, per diem, etc. should be built into the prices bid for the existing lines for the contract; No other costs shall be billed to LDWF other than the prices bid for each line and no lines added.

Mobilization:

See price sheet for mobilization cost breakdown.

Consulting for parts:

All costs for contractor consultation to assist LDWF personnel with lists of needed parts, materials, and supplies needed for the repairs are to be included in the appropriate line for mobilization for the project.

Repair of eroded/washed out dirt work:

Minor: Requiring light equipment

Major: Requiring heavy equipment, defined as requiring an 18-wheeler and low-boy to be transported to the site.

Backfill and Restoration:

Backfill and restoration compaction must be done according to specification and contract documents for State of Louisiana, Volume 1 of 2, Booker Fowler Fish Hatchery, State Project No. 16-514-90-B-08 Part 1, page 0221-6. A copy is available upon request.
