## **SPECIAL PROVISIONS**

### **STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS**

The Standard Specifications referred to herein are the 1997 City of Baton Rouge, Parish of East Baton Rouge Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction. The Standard Specifications are hereby amended to include the following Special Provisions and where applicable shall take precedence over the aforementioned Standard Specifications. When any part of the Standard Specifications is unaltered by the following Special Provisions, the unaltered provisions of the Standard Specifications shall remain in effect.

Copies of the Standard Specifications may be obtained from the Department of Public Works, Engineering Division, Room 130, 1100 Laurel Street, Baton Rouge, LA 70802 or Post Office Box 1471, Baton Rouge, Louisiana 70821 (Telephone No. [225] 389-3186).

### **NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

For Individual Bids (Quotations) totaling \$25,000 and greater, the following shall apply:

- a). A Bid Bond, cashier's check or certified check is required to be submitted with the proposal (if applicable).
- b). A Performance and Payment Bond will be required for the contract (if applicable).
- c). The Contract shall be approved by the Metropolitan Council (if applicable).
- d). The Contract shall be recorded with the Recorder of Mortgages (if applicable).
- e). Retainage shall be withheld until receipt of a clear lien certificate following the 45-day lien period after the Metropolitan Council has approved final acceptance of the Contract (if applicable).

The above requirements do not apply to individual quotations less than \$25,000.00

### **EXAMINATION OF PLANS, SPECIFICATION, SPECIAL PROVISIONS AND SITE OF WORK**

Before preparing his bid, each bidder is expected to make a field examination of the proposed work and to fully acquaint himself with conditions relating to remediation and labor so that he may fully understand the facilities, difficulties and restrictions attending the execution of the work under this contract. Bidders should thoroughly examine and be familiar with the Plans, Specifications and Contract Documents.

Submission of a bid shall be considered prima facie evidence that the bidder has made such an examination and is satisfied as to the conditions to be encountered in performing the work and as to the requirements of the plans, project specifications and documents.

**PROPOSAL GUARANTY** (Required for Bids \$25,000 and Greater)

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond acceptable to the City-Parish in an amount equal to at least 5% of the proposal, payable without condition to the City-Parish as a guarantee that the bidder, if awarded the contract, will promptly execute such contract in accordance with the proposal and in a manner and form required by the contract documents and will furnish good and sufficient bond for faithful performance of the same.

When a bid bond is used, it shall be written by a surety company currently qualified to do business in Louisiana and currently on the U.S. Department of the Treasury Financial Management Service list of approved bonding companies published annually in the Federal Register, or by an insurance company currently qualified to do business in Louisiana with at least an A- rating in the latest printing of the A.M. Best's Key Rating Guide to write individual bonds up to 10% of policyholders' surplus as shown in the A.M. Best's Key Rating Guide.

**SURETY BOND** (Required for Bids \$25,000 and Greater)

Prior to execution of the contract, the Contractor shall file with the Purchasing Director a surety bond on a form provided or approved by the City Parish. The Contractor shall pay all costs therefore.

The bond shall be written by a surety company qualified to do business in Louisiana and on the U.S. Department of the Treasury Financial Management Service list of approved bonding companies published annually in the Federal Register, or by an insurance company qualified to do business in Louisiana with at least an A- rating in the latest printing of A.M. Best's Key Rating Guide to write individual bonds up to 10% of policyholders' surplus as shown in A.M. Best's Key Rating Guide.

The bond shall be in effect at 100% of the contract amount until completion of the 1-year warranty period specified and until all claims for materials and labor are paid, subject to local ordinances and state lien laws.

The bond shall be so conditioned as to assure performance by the Contractor of all work under said contract within the time limit prescribed in a manner satisfactory to the City-Parish; that materials and workmanship will be free from defects; and that should defects appear prior to completion of the 1-year warranty period specified in Subsection 4-6, the Contractor shall make good such defects and make all replacements and adjustments required within a reasonable time after being notified by the Department to do so.

Should any surety become insufficient, the Contractor shall renew said bond with good and sufficient sureties within 10 days after receiving notice from the City-Parish.

**AWARD AND EXECUTION OF CONTRACT**

A total bid or quotation of \$150,000.00 and under will be considered a quotation and is not within the purview of the Public Bid Law (LA RS 38:2212 et.seq). It is the City-Parish's intent to obtain fair and competitive quotations. However, the City-Parish specifically reserves the right to evaluate quotations, waive irregularities or informalities not affecting price or quality, to accept the quotation which is in the best interest of the City-Parish, and to reject all quotations if that is in the best interest of the City-Parish.

## TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

This specification covers the remediation of the structure(s) located at addresses specified on the proposal form. The Contractor shall furnish all necessary labor, tools, equipment and insurance to accomplish the work as specified herein and in the Instructions to Bidders. **NOTE: Contractor is required to visit the jobsite prior to submission of bid. See Mandatory Job Site Visit Form.**

### **PERMITS, LICENSES AND AUTHORITY TO BEGIN WORK**

The following criteria must be met before the Contractor begins work:

1. Obtain all permits and licenses and pay all fees.
2. Give all notices required for the lawful demolition and/or removal of the structures and appurtenances.
3. Receive notice to proceed by City-Parish.

The work is to be done under the supervision of the Fire, and all questions are to be directed to the Fire Chief. The Inspection Division is to be notified at completion so a final inspection can be made in order that payment may be authorized.

### **SCOPE OF WORK**

#### **Tasks:**

- Remove the existing r-panel roof, vents, and insulation (approximately 3,200 sq. ft.)
- Install new vinyl insulation (approximately 3,200 sq. ft.)
- Install new R-panel galvalume roofing (approximately 3,200 sq. ft.)
- Install 10' ridge vents (3 each)
- Install new rake metal (approximately 80 linear feet)
- Install new ridge metal (approximately 78 linear feet)
- Flash all existing penetrations (approximately 3 locations)
- Salvage existing gutters and downspouts (approximately 160 linear feet)
- Contractor's warranty on workmanship begins on day of completion
- 

#### **Additional Notes:**

- All work shall be done from 08:00 a.m. to 03:30 p.m.
- Contractor will begin work within thirty (30) days of notification of award and complete the project within a two week time frame (assuming no abnormal delays due to weather, natural disaster, etc.)

#### **Project Conditions:**

- All work must be coordinated with Fire Department personnel.
- It is the responsibility of the contractor to insure the proper environment necessary for the successful completion of the project.
- The contractor shall be responsible for providing lifts/scaffolds, if necessary, for all work.
- The contractor, its subcontractors, and all their employees shall be subject to and shall at all times conform with all rules, regulations, policies and procedures pertaining to the Public Safety Complex. Any violations or disregard for rules, regulations, or policies may be cause for immediate termination.
- All personal packages brought onto and/or removed from the Fire Department location may be subject to inspection. Firearms and/or explosives shall NOT be brought onto the property. VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED.
- The project shall be completed within a three-week time frame from the start of the project. Extensions to contract length must be requested from and only granted by authorized Fire Department personnel.
- Before this contract is acceptable and complete, contractor shall clean up and remove from the premises all debris resulting from work.
- Contractor shall warranty all materials and labor for a period of one (1) year from the date of final acceptance.
