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REPORTS OF OFFICERS, BOARDS, AND STANDING COMMITTEES

Mr. Walther discussed Legislation updates on the preference of Louisiana cattle fed and harvested out of state to return with traceable documentation, Alternative Livestock, Release of Game, Foul, or Fish, 3 year apprenticeship for turtle farm license, Transportation of live feral swine, and the Reauthorization of LBIC.

Dr. Stacy gave updates on Equine Piroplasmosis, Animal Traceability, and other Veterinary Health programs.

OLD BUSINESS

Dr. Stacy advised the board of a new USDA approved Equine Infectious Anemia Lab (EIA) in Leesville, Louisiana owned by Dr. George Brandon. Mr. Jesse Brandon will be managing the lab.

NEW BUSINESS

Dr. Stacy introduced an application from Dr. Doug Pesnell for a new Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) lab in Natchitoches, Louisiana.

MOTION:

Mr. Ardoin made a motion to give board approval for the new private EIA testing lab in Natchitoches, Louisiana. Dr. Greene seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Mr. Walther gave the status of three livestock markets in Louisiana that have ceased operations or will cease operations – Miller Livestock DeQuincy, West Monroe, and Dominique Lafayette. He stated Miller Livestock Market, Inc. would like to extend their charter for one year due to their business reorganization. Mr. Walther also gave an overview of numbers and species of animals inspected by LDAF at Louisiana sales.

MOTION

Mr. Holdman gave a motion to allow Miller Livestock Market to extend their charter for one year. Mr. Robertson seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Dr. Stacy announced the formation of species working groups to revise LDAF Title 7 regulations and the state VMO's would develop and head the groups. Board members were encouraged to participate in these groups. A preliminary report of any actions taken by these groups will be reported at the next board meeting.
