Chairman Lala advised the Commission Members of a NOTICE OF OPEN ENROLLMENT from Louisiana Department of Justice, dated August 27, 2024, and a letter issued by Governor Landry, dated November 22, 2024, regarding the Louisiana Department of Justice's Occupational Licensing Review Program. At this time, Chairman Lala asked Counselor Reggie to provide details and lead the discussion. Counselor Reggie advised the Commission Members that in both the Governor Landry's letter and Louisiana Department of Justice's notice are to inform the licensing boards that the Occupational Licensing Review Program (OLRP) provides active state supervision to ensure that boards and board members avoid liability under federal antitrust laws. The participation is voluntary, and there is a cost to the Commission to participate in the program. The deadline to enroll in the OLRP for the period of January 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026 is December 31, 2024.

After and brief discussion, Commissioner Hixson made a motion to participate in the OLRP and to authorize Chairman Lala to execute the agreement with the Louisiana Department of Justice. Commissioner Krake seconded this motion. All in favor and it was unanimously approved.

At 1:16 p.m., Chairman Lala called for an executive session for legal advice. Commissioner Lane made a motion to enter into an executive session. It was seconded by Commissioner Hixson.

At 1:44 p.m. the executive session ended and the Commission meeting resumed. There being no further business, Commissioner Lane made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 1:45 p.m. Commissioner Hocevar seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.
