COMMISSION MEETING

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Red River Waterway Commission was called to order by Chair Designee, Troy Roussell, in the Activity Center of the Red River Waterway Commission Grand Ecore RV Park located at 1071 Tauzin Island Road in Natchitoches, Louisiana.

2 ROLL CALL

Roll was called and a quorum was present. Others in attendance were asked to identify themselves and offer any comments they may have regarding the agenda. However, no comments were offered.

4. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

By motion of Commissioner Lattier, seconded by Commissioner Crutchfield, the agenda was unanimously approved. Comments from the public were called for, however, none were offered.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

By motion of Commissioner Crutchfield, seconded by Commissioner Lattier, the minutes of the February 19, 2020 meeting were unanimously approved. Note: No meetings were held in March, April, and May due to the Coronavirus.

6. TREASURER'S REPORT

By motion of Commissioner Crutchfield, seconded by Commissioner Fletcher, the Expenditures, Financial Statements, Investment Reports, & Fund Balance Report for the months of February, March, April, and May 2020 were unanimously approved.

7. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- a) Contracts
- 1. <u>Consideration of Approval of Contract with Air Data Solutions</u>: By motion of Commissioner Lattier, seconded by Commissioner Fletcher, the Commission unanimously approved a two (2) year contract with Air Data Solutions for aerial aquatic vegetation surveys and directed staff to enlist such services on an as needed basis up to the 2020 budgeted amount.
- 2. <u>Consideration of Approval of Teague Parkway Recreation Area Picnic Shelter Painting Proposals</u>: By motion of Commissioner Lattier, seconded by Commissioner Deville, the Commission unanimously approved award of contract to Womack Brothers, LLC of Rayville, Louisiana in the amount of \$32,400.00.
- 3. Consideration of Approval of Grand Ecore RV Park Operator Agreement: By motion of Commissioner Lattier, seconded by Commissioner Greer, the Commission unanimously approved authorizing staff to work with current Grand Ecore RV Park operator, Layne Miller, on a two (2) year contract extension agreement to commence on July 28, 2020. Contract extension agreement to include terms for the transitioning to a cash-less basis for operations and that of support documentation with regards to promotion/advertising of the Grand Ecore RV Park.
- b) Land Management, Legal Affairs & Affirmative Action
- 1. <u>Consideration of Award of Public Bid Land Lease/Lower Gin Lake Realignment/120 Acres</u>: By motion of Commissioner Sayes, seconded by Commissioner Jones, the Commission unanimously approved award of public bid lease to Mr. Sammy Guillot for \$9,000.00 (\$15.00 per acre) for the 5-year lease term.

- Consideration of Request for Leaseback Renewal/Lock & Dam 1/Tract 1/43 Acres: By morion of Commissioner Jones, seconded by Commissioner Deville, and one abstention by Commissioner Sayes, the Commission approved award of the 5-year leaseback renewal with Agri-South Group, LLC for \$3,655.00 (\$17.00 per acre) for the 5-year lease term.
- 3. <u>Consideration of Request for Leaseback Renewal/Lock & Dam 1/Tract 1/Segments B & B-1/106.9</u>
 <u>Acres</u>: By motion of Commissioner Jones, seconded by Commissioner Deville and one abstention by Commissioner Sayes, the Commission approved award of the 5-year leaseback renewal with Agri-South for \$8,017.50 (\$15.00 per acre) for the 5-year lease term.
- 4. <u>Consideration of Approval of Land Lease Extension/Lock & Dam 1/Tracts 3 & 6/5.7 Acres</u>: By motion of Commissioner Jones, seconded by Commissioner Fletcher, the Commission unanimously approved award of the 5-year lease extension to Mr. Ricky Dupuy, with a ten percent (10%) increase in the lease premium, for a total lease amount of \$470.25 (\$16.50 per acre) for the 5-year lease term.
- 5. <u>Consideration of Request for Storm Damage Assistance/Lock & Dam 1/Tract A/640 Acres</u>

 By motion of Commissioner Sayes, seconded by Commissioner Jones, the Commission unar imously approved providing long term lessee, Delta Ridge Ranch, LLC, assistance in the cost of clearing storm damage from access road that was caused by a tornado on April 22, 2020 in the amc unt of \$2,900.00.

- 1. Recreation Area Status Report

Mr. Mike Boydstun highlighted the prepared report provided in the meeting packet, noting that there had been 126, 000 visitors to the District recreation areas during the month of May 2020. Updated maintenance items include, but not limited to:

- Cleanup following high-water is underway from the Alexandria Levee Park north to the Shreveport/Bossier recreation sites
- Colfax activity center design/construction costs to be presented at the July 2020 meeting
- Dredge is currently in the area of the Red River South Marina
