

**Louisiana State Board of Examiners of Psychologists
LICENSED SPECIALIST IN SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGY
ADVISORY COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES: March 19, 2019**

FINAL APPROVED: June 4, 2019

The Licensed Specialist in School Psychology Advisory Committee [herein Committee] of the Louisiana State Board of Examiners of Psychologists [Board] was noticed and agenda posted March 18, 2019. Dr. Amy Morvant, called the meeting to order on March 19, 2019 at 1:38 p.m. at 4334 S. Sherwood Forest Boulevard, Suite #C-150, Baton Rouge, LA 70816. Present were Committee Members, Dr. Amy Morvant, Dr. George Hebert, Ms. Stacey Johnson and Ex Officio Member Jaime Monic.

Dr. Hebert moved to approve the agenda for March 19, 2019. The motion passed unanimously.

The committee reviewed the minutes from September 25, 2018. Dr. Hebert moved to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Hebert moved to enter Executive Session to review the application for licensure of Anna Young Pardue. The motion passed unanimously. Dr. Hebert moved to exit Executive Session to enter the following:

Dr. Morvant reviewed the Application for Licensed Specialist in School Psychology of **Anna M. Young Pardue, S.S.P.** Dr. Morvant, finding that the requirements for licensure have been met, moved that the Committee confirm the Candidacy status of Ms. Pardue and recommend her to the Board for licensure as a Specialist in School Psychology pending receipt of passing Jurisprudence Examination. The motion passed unanimously.

DISCUSSION:

1. Committee Updates: Ms. Monic reported that applicants continued to have trouble communicating with NASP and it was holding up applicants trying to complete their file for committee review. The Committee investigated options for verifying an individual is NASP Certified and agreed that a copy of the certificate from the applicant along with administration verification from the NASP website would be sufficient. The Committee also reviewed the licensing and verification process to require confirmation of Praxis scores and formal documentation of internship. Dr. Morvant agreed to assist with updating the supervision documentation form.

Ms. Johnson proposed the Committee present again at the Louisiana School Psychology Association convention. The Committee agreed and requested Ms. Monic affirm the proposal with the LSBEP.

2. Chapter 42: Ethics for the LSSP – The committee discussed and agreed on final revisions to Chapter 42 (ethics) of the Louisiana Administrative Code. Ms. Monic agreed to draft a final copy for review by the committee before sending to the LSBEP for approval.

3. LSSP Call for Nominees for upcoming vacancy. The committee reviewed the self-nomination form and discussed nomination requirements, affirming that the nominee for the upcoming vacancy should be a licensed psychologist with a school specialty.

4. Next Meeting Dates.The committee affirmed that the next meeting dates for the committee would be June 4, 2019, September 3, 2019 and December 3, 2019.

Dr. Morvant moved to adjourn the meeting at 4:09 p.m. The motion passed unanimously.
