1 MR. LAGRANGE:

2 All right, y'all. It's 10:05. We're
3 going to go ahead and call the meeting to
4 order of the Board of Certification and
5 Training for Solid Waste Management
6 Operators in Patterson, Louisiana,
7 Patterson Civic Center. We'll start off
8 with role call from Ms. Bordelon, please.

9 MS. BORDELON:

10 Danny Hylton?

11 MR. HYLTON:

12 Here.

13 MS. BORDELON:

14 Jason Creel?

15 MR. CREEL:

16 Here.

17 MS. BORDELON:

18 Beau Legrange?

19 MR. LAGRANGE:

20 Present.

21 MS. BORDELON:

22 Dr. Ricardo de Abreu?

23 DR. DE ABREU:

24 Here.

25 MS. BORDELON:

1 David Greene?

2 Connie Henry?

3 MS. HENRY:

4 Here.

5 MS. BORDELON:

6 Bubba Wynn?

7 MR. WYNN:

8 Here.

9 MS. BORDELON:

10 Wes Wyche?

11 Mia Townsel?

12 MR. LAGRANGE:

13 Thank you. And we have a quorum.

14 First thing on our agenda is review
15 of the October 8, 2019 minutes.

16 MS. BORDELON:

17 We have not received the minutes yet.

18 MR. LAGRANGE:

19 Okay. So we will review them for the
20 next meeting, I anticipate.

21 All right. Next, consideration of
22 operator certifications. First item,
23 review of applications for certification.
24 I think we have four. I'll take one at a
25 time, and if anybody has any questions or

1 comments we will address them.

2 First one is Stuart Ancelet for an
3 Incinerator waste handling, type II-A,
4 Level B license.

5 MR. WYNN:

6 I have no objection with him.

7 MR. LAGRANGE:

8 Me either.

9 Yolanda, since you are -- you can
10 represent DEQ, do you want to comment on
11 this -- this is a new permit -- facility
12 being permitted?

13 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

14 Which one is that? I'm sorry.

15 MR. CREEL:

16 Stuart Ancelet. MedGreen.

17 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

18 MedGreen. You want to know the
19 status of application? Is that what you
20 want to know?

21 MR. LAGRANGE:

22 Yeah.

23 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

24 Okay. Right now, we have completed
25 the technical review of the application

1 and the last outstanding deficiency is
2 regarding the buffer zone. They are
3 waiting for a buffer zone waver from
4 Acadia Parish as well as DOTD. So, if
5 they continue with the permit application
6 for this particular site, once we get the
7 buffer zone wavers from those two entities
8 then we will move forward and deem the
9 application technically complete and then
10 we will put it on public review.

11 MR. LAGRANGE:

12 Public review.

13 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

14 Yeah.

15 MR. LAGRANGE:

16 Okay. Thank you.

17 Does anyone have any questions?

18 Comments?

19 All right. We'll move on to Nelson
20 Crader, for a Landfill, Level B.

21 It shows he has a certificate now.
22 Is that a conditional or is that a regular
23 certificate?

24 MS. BORDELON:

25 Conditional.

1 MR. LAGRANGE:

2 He currently holds a conditional.

3 MR. HYLTON:

4 I think he went back and added some
5 prior supervisory experience that he did
6 not have in his original application,
7 which should give him his time
8 requirements for a B, non-conditional.

9 MR. LAGRANGE:

10 Okay. Does anybody else have any
11 questions or comments?

12 DR. DE ABREU:

13 So, he has one year, about one
14 year -- a little more than one year in
15 solid waste management then he has one
16 more -- several years in construction.

17 MS. BORDELON:

18 Correct.

19 DR. DE ABREU:

20 Supervising people too, so I have no
21 objection.

22 MR. LAGRANGE:

23 So, for a Level B, that qualifies.

24 DR. DE ABREU:

25 That qualifies, yes.

1 MR. LAGRANGE:

2 Okay. Next, we have Steve Haik for
3 an Incinerator, waste handling, type II-A,
4 Level B.

5 All right. This company is Med
6 Geaux. The other company was MedGreen.
7 Is that two different companies? Does
8 anyone know?

9 MR. HAIK:

10 Yes, sir?

11 MR. LAGRANGE:

12 Med Geaux versus MedGreen. Is that
13 two different facilities?

14 MR. HAIK:

15 No, sir. Med Geaux is the
16 transporting company.

17 MR. LAGRANGE:

18 Okay. So, for Med Geaux, you're not
19 required to have a certification?

20 MR. HAIK:

21 Just for transportation regulations
22 and rules from DEQ and DHH.

23 MR. CREEL:

24 I think we went over this last time.

25 MR. HAIK:

1 That's two different facilities.

2 MR. LAGRANGE:

3 Right. The actual incinerator
4 facility requires a permit.

5 MR. HAIK:

6 Yes, sir. For MedGreen.

7 MR. LAGRANGE:

8 And requires certified operators.

9 MR. HAIK:

10 Uh-huh (yes).

11 MR. LAGRANGE:

12 But Med Geaux, which is -- you said
13 is the transportation of waste, I don't
14 think we oversee operators for that, do
15 we?

16 MR. HYLTON:

17 Transporter ID number --

18 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

19 Yeah.

20 MR. HYLTON:

21 -- would be all they need.

22 MR. WYNN:

23 And they have no transfer facility,
24 do they?

25 MR. HAIK:

1 Do I have what?

2 MR. WYNN:

3 You don't -- y'all don't have a
4 transfer facility do you?

5 MR. HAIK:

6 Well --

7 MR. LAGRANGE:

8 Excuse me. I'm sorry. For the
9 record, state your name, sir.

10 MR. HAIK:

11 I'm Steve Haik.

12 MR. LAGRANGE:

13 Steve Haik. Thank you.

14 MR. HAIK:

15 A pleasure to be here. Thank you
16 very much.

17 The only transfer facility we have is
18 a storage unit regulated by DHH.

19 MR. LAGRANGE:

20 So, I guess my question is: Why are
21 you applying for an operator permit --
22 operator certification, if it's under a
23 transportation company? You work for a
24 transportation company.

25 MR. HAIK:

1 I do. Yes, sir. But I also will be
2 working for MedGreen.

3 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

4 So maybe --

5 MR. LAGRANGE:

6 So, you will -- you're also going to
7 work at MedGreen, in the operations of the
8 incinerator handling?

9 MR. HAIK:

10 Yes, sir.

11 MR. LAGRANGE:

12 Okay. So, your application didn't
13 reflect that, that's why I was questioning
14 it. It said Med Geaux. The other one
15 said MedGreen.

16 MR. HAIK:

17 Okay.

18 MR. LAGRANGE:

19 And MedGreen's the applicant that's
20 getting permitted.

21 MR. HAIK:

22 Yes, sir.

23 MR. LAGRANGE:

24 That's why I questioned it.

25 MR. HAIK:

1 Yes, sir.

2 MR. LAGRANGE:

3 Okay. Anybody have any other
4 questions?

5 All right. Next is Matthew Vidrine
6 for Incinerator, waste handling, type II-A
7 Level A.

8 Any questions?

9 MR. HYLTON:

10 I'm a little fuzzy on the years of
11 experience. This previous employment from
12 '15 to '19, is acceptable experience for
13 this license he's applying for?

14 MR. LAGRANGE:

15 The -- I think Mr. Vidrine is here.

16 Mr. Vidrine?

17 MR. VIDRINE:

18 Yes, sir.

19 MR. LAGRANGE:

20 We may want to ask you a couple
21 questions on this.

22 First, I see the site name is
23 Thermaldyne, LLC?

24 MR. VIDRINE:

25 Yes, sir. That's who I currently

1 work for.

2 MR. LAGRANGE:

3 That's who you work for?

4 MR. VIDRINE:

5 Yes, sir.

6 If these guys are permitted, I'm
7 going to go and move to these guys.

8 MR. LAGRANGE:

9 Okay. But you don't work for -- at
10 this time.

11 MR. VIDRINE:

12 I am co-employed, I guess you could
13 say.

14 MR. LAGRANGE:

15 Do what?

16 MR. VIDRINE:

17 Contingent on their permit
18 application.

19 MR. LAGRANGE:

20 I got you. But currently you're
21 working for Thermaladyne, LLC?

22 MR. VIDRINE:

23 Yes, sir. I'm currently the
24 environmental manager over there.

25 MR. LAGRANGE:

1 And what do they do?

2 MR. VIDRINE:

3 They take hazardous secondary
4 materials and they thermally absorb them
5 and they sell the oil that they get.

6 MR. LAGRANGE:

7 Okay. And then, in your position, I
8 think was a question. Mr. Hylton had
9 question?

10 MR. HYLTON:

11 Yeah, prior to that.

12 MR. VIDRINE:

13 At Eagle?

14 MR. HYLTON:

15 Yes. Were you handling waste there?
16 Processing waste?

17 MR. VIDRINE:

18 No, sir. I was the head of waste
19 permitting for Eagle.

20 MR. HYLTON:

21 Yeah.

22 MR. VIDRINE:

23 I worked under Ray Stern.

24 MR. HYLTON:

25 Is that going to count as processing

1 experience? I'm just looking at the
2 timeline there.

3 MR. LAGRANGE:

4 Well, it's if he has the solid
5 waste -- that is solid waste experience.
6 I'm looking. I see some --

7 MR. CREEL:

8 His degree counts towards that, as
9 well.

10 MR. LAGRANGE:

11 That's what I was about to ask. You
12 didn't check if had a college degree.

13 MR. CREEL:

14 Yes, he's got a science master's, so
15 he's covered.

16 MR. LAGRANGE:

17 Okay. I see it now. I'm sorry.
18 Yeah, so the engineering gives some
19 credit, years credit.

20 MR. HYLTON:

21 If it's an engineering degree.

22 MR. LAGRANGE:

23 It gives you one year of credit, and
24 he's got four years if he was working
25 as -- in solid waste permitting for

1 clients, I guess. Eagle --

2 MR. VIDRINE:

3 Yes, sir.

4 MR. LAGRANGE:

5 -- deals with clients.

6 DR. DE ABREU:

7 And did you help develop operational
8 plans for facilities as part of the permit
9 application?

10 MR. VIDRINE:

11 Yes, sir.

12 MR. LAGRANGE:

13 Okay. Any other questions?

14 Okay.

15 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

16 I think you had prepared --

17 MR. VIDRINE:

18 I did prepare this application --

19 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

20 He prepared the application --

21 MR. VIDRINE:

22 -- before I left to go to

23 Thermaldyne.

24 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

25 Yeah.

1 MR. LAGRANGE:

2 Okay.

3 All right. If there's no other
4 comments or questions on these four
5 applications for certifications, I would
6 entertain a motion --

7 MR. WYNN:

8 I'll make a motion.

9 MR. LAGRANGE:

10 -- to approve all four applications.

11 I've got a motion by Mr. Wynn.

12 DR. DE ABREU:

13 I second.

14 MR. LAGRANGE:

15 Second by Dr. de Abreu. And this --
16 I want to read the names again.

17 This would be for applications of
18 Stuart Ancelet, Nelson Crader, Steve Haik,
19 and Matthew Vidrine.

20 Okay. Any discussion on the motion?

21 Any objections?

22 Motion carried. Thank you. We'll
23 move to the next item.

24 MR. VIDRINE:

25 Thank y'all.

1 MR. LAGRANGE:

2 Application for conditional
3 certificates.

4 And we have --

5 MS. BORDELON:

6 We have none.

7 MR. LAGRANGE:

8 We have none. Okay.

9 Next is application -- is review of
10 extensions to conditional certificates.

11 We have one. Mr. --

12 MS. BORDELON:

13 Dennis Gibson.

14 MR. LAGRANGE:

15 -- Dennis Gibson for a C&D, type III,
16 Level A conditional. And this would just
17 be an extension to his conditional.

18 MR. CREEL:

19 Yes.

20 MR. LAGRANGE:

21 Do I have a motion to approve?

22 MS. HENRY:

23 So moved.

24 MR. LAGRANGE:

25 I've got a motion.

1 MR. CREEL:

2 Second.

3 MR. LAGRANGE:

4 Second. Motion by Ms. Henry, second
5 by Mr. Creel. Any discussion?

6 Any objections?

7 Motion carried. Thank you.

8 Next, we're going to move to review
9 of applications for recertification, which
10 looks like we have none.

11 MR. HYLTON:

12 Yes, we do. She just passed
13 something out.

14 MR. LAGRANGE:

15 Applications for recertification.

16 MR. LAGRANGE:

17 Recertification. Uh-huh (yes).

18 MR. LAGRANGE:

19 We do have one?

20 MS. BORDELON:

21 Yes, they should be in the agenda
22 packet that I passed out.

23 MR. LAGRANGE:

24 I'm sorry. I got it. Okay.

25 Recertification application, we have

1 recertification applications that are
2 complete: Russell Duncan, Landfill, Level
3 A, Waste Management -- Reliable Landfill;
4 Percy Hollins, C&D, Level B, Gentilly
5 Landfill; John F. Mickey, Transfer
6 Station, Level A, Stranco Solid Waste
7 Management; and Michael Weekly, C&D, Level
8 A, Gentilly Landfill. And he will
9 complete ten hours in Lafayette. So, we
10 will -- let's take the first three who are
11 all complete, right?

12 MS. BORDELON:

13 Uh-huh (yes).

14 MR. LAGRANGE:

15 Okay. Do I have a motion to
16 recertify those three?

17 MR. WYNN:

18 I'll make that motion.

19 MR. HYLTON:

20 (INDICATING)

21 MR. LAGRANGE:

22 Moved by Mr. Wynn. Second by
23 Mr. Hylton.

24 Any discussion?

25 Any objection?

1 All in favor, 'aye'.

2 ALL:

3 Aye.

4 MR. LAGRANGE:

5 Motion carried.

6 Okay. We'll take Michael Weekly for
7 the C&D, Level A recertification. Do I
8 have a motion to approve recertification
9 contingent upon completion of his last ten
10 hours, which will be within the timeframe
11 of the expiration of the certificate?

12 MS. BORDELON:

13 Right.

14 MR. LAGRANGE:

15 Do I have a motion?

16 MR. CREEL:

17 So moved.

18 MR. LAGRANGE:

19 Moved by Mr. Creel.

20 MS. HENRY:

21 Second.

22 MS. BORDELON:

23 Second by Ms. Henry. Any discussion?

24 Any objection?

25 Motion carried. Thank you.

1 All right. Next we will issue --
2 issuance of operator certifications, and
3 that is -- Ms. Bordelon, will you read the
4 names for issuance of operator
5 certification?

6 MS. BORDELON:

7 Uh-huh (yes).

8 Stuart Ancelet, Incinerator, Level B;
9 Nelson Crader, Landfill, Level B, Steve
10 Haik, Incinerator, Level B, Matthew
11 Vidrine, Incinerator, Level A, and Troy
12 Barrilleaux, Separation, Level A.

13 MR. LAGRANGE:

14 Okay. Well, we haven't taken up his
15 application yet.

16 MS. BORDELON:

17 Oh, that's right. Sorry.

18 MR. LAGRANGE:

19 So, let's do the first four:
20 Ancelet, Crader, Haik, and Vidrine. Do I
21 have a motion to issue operator
22 certificates?

23 MS. HENRY:

24 So moved.

25 MR. LAGRANGE:

1 Moved by Ms. Henry.

2 DR. DE ABREU:

3 I second.

4 MR. LAGRANGE:

5 Second by Dr. de Abreu. Any

6 discussion?

7 Any objection?

8 Motion carries.

9 Okay. Next we will take up request
10 for reciprocity from Mr. Troy Barrilleaux,
11 for a Separation facility, Level A.

12 Suzanne, give us a brief estimation
13 on his application.

14 MS. BORDELON:

15 All right. Mr. Barrilleaux, he's
16 been attending all the classes, he just --
17 it slipped by him that he just hadn't
18 submitted his application for
19 recertification, and when he did I
20 realized he had the MOLO certification and
21 that he could apply for reciprocity based
22 on that -- on his MOLO certification.

23 MR. LAGRANGE:

24 Okay. And his certificate expired?

25 MS. BORDELON:

1 In September of '18.

2 MR. LAGRANGE:

3 Okay.

4 All right. Any discussion on that
5 application?

6 Hearing none, do I have a motion to
7 approve reciprocity and issue a regular
8 certificate?

9 MR. WYNN:

10 I'll make that motion.

11 MR. LAGRANGE:

12 Moved by Mr. Wynn.

13 MR. CREEL:

14 Second.

15 MR. LAGRANGE:

16 Second by Mr. Creel. Thank you.

17 Any discussion?

18 Any objection?

19 Motion carried.

20 All right. Next we will go to
21 committee reports.

22 Mr. Danny Hylton, Awards Committee.

23 MR. HYLTON:

24 Nothing to report.

25 MR. LAGRANGE:

1 Nothing to report. Thank you.

2 We have a vacancy for the Testing
3 Committee, and I will appoint Mr. Bubba
4 Wynn to head up the testing.

5 Do you have any report?

6 MR. WYNN:

7 There's none.

8 MR. LAGRANGE:

9 We have a vacancy on the Continuing
10 Education Committee, and I would like to
11 appoint Ricard de Abreu to head up
12 Continuing Education.

13 DR. DE ABREU:

14 Okay.

15 MR. LAGRANGE:

16 Okay. Do you have any reports?

17 DR. DE ABREU:

18 Not yet.

19 MR. LAGRANGE:

20 All right. And or Nominating
21 Committee, Ms. Henry?

22 MS. HENRY:

23 Suzanne received Danny's letter.
24 They're still waiting on someone to be
25 appointed for Troy's spot. At this time

1 she's received no information.

2 MR. LAGRANGE:

3 Okay. And that's for LMA, right?

4 MS. BORDELON:

5 Uh-huh (yes).

6 MR. LAGRANGE:

7 Okay. Any other business? Do we
8 have any other business?

9 MR. HYLTON:

10 Miscellaneous question.

11 MR. LAGRANGE:

12 Yes, sir.

13 MR. HYLTON:

14 We just approved a certificate for
15 Nelson Crader.

16 MR. LAGRANGE:

17 Extension to his conditional.

18 MR. HYLTON:

19 Okay.

20 MS. BORDELON:

21 No, no, no.

22 MR. HYLTON:

23 No, he's got his experience in now.

24 We're going to give him -- yeah.

25 MS. BORDELON:

1 Yeah, right.

2 MR. HYLTON:

3 The question is: When is the
4 certificate valid? Does he have to have
5 it in his hand? Is it valid this minute?

6 MS. BORDELON:

7 It's valid today.

8 MR. HYLTON:

9 So, he could -- he works at my
10 facility, and there's some scheduling --
11 vacation scheduling cutting us kind of
12 short on operators. He can serve as a B
13 today.

14 MS. BORDELON:

15 Today.

16 MR. HYLTON:

17 Okay.

18 MS. BORDELON:

19 Because -- yeah, because he's paid
20 the certificate, so -- and the Board
21 approved it as of today.

22 MR. HYLTON:

23 Okay. Thank you.

24 MR. WYNN:

25 Merry Christmas.

1 MR. HYLTON:

2 He's about to work in someone's place
3 now.

4 MR. LAGRANGE:

5 Okay. Any other business?

6 Any public comments?

7 Hearing none, I'll entertain a
8 motion.

9 MR. WYNN:

10 I'll make that motion that we
11 adjourn.

12 MR. LAGRANGE:

13 Excuse me, before you make that
14 motion, Mr. Bubba -- Mr. Wynn, I'd like to
15 just wish all of you a very happy and safe
16 Christmas and New Year's and hope you have
17 time to spend with your family and
18 friends.

19 MR. WYNN:

20 And we look forward to 2020.

21 MR. LAGRANGE:

22 2020, yes indeed.

23 All right, now I'll entertain your
24 motion.

25 MR. WYNN:

1 I make a motion we adjourn.

2 MR. LAGRANGE:

3 Motion by Mr. Wynn.

4 DR. DE ABREU:

5 Second.

6 MR. LAGRANGE:

7 Second by Dr. de Abreu.

8 Any objections?

9 This meeting is adjourned. Thank
10 y'all very much.
