2 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

3 I'm going to call the meeting to order  
4 for the Board of Certification and Training  
5 for Solid Waste Management Operators. I'll  
6 ask Ms. Bordelon to call the roll please.

7 **MS. BORDELON:**

8 Denny Mize?

9 **MR. MIZE:**

10 Present.

11 **MS. BORDELON:**

12 James Berthelot?

13 **MR. BERTHELOT:**

14 Present.

15 **MS. BORDELON:**

16 Scott Lyons?

17 **MR. LYONS:**

18 Here.

19 **MS. BORDELON:**

20 Terrance Stewart?

21 **MR. STEWART:**

22 Here.

23 **MS. BORDELON:**

24 Krystal Perkins?

25 **MS. PERKINS:**

1           Here.

2           **MS. BORDELON:**

3           William Mollere?

4           **MR. MOLLERE:**

5           Here.

6           **MS. BORDELON:**

7           Fred Williams?

8           **MR. WILLIAMS:**

9           Here.

10          **MS. BORDELON:**

11          Jonathan Fourrier?

12          **MR. FOURRIER:**

13          Here.

14          **MS. BORDELON:**

15          Sam Philips?

16          (No response.)

17          And Henry Lagrange?

18          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

19          Present.

20                 Thank you. The next order of business,  
21 I want to take this opportunity to extend a  
22 warm welcome to our two newest board  
23 members. We have Ms. Krystal Perkins. Ms.  
24 Krystal, tell us a little bit about  
25 yourself.

1           **MS. PERKINS:**

2                   I have been a solid waste manager for  
3           the East Baton Rouge Parish for almost five  
4           years in June where I oversee both the  
5           operations and the collection contracts.

6           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

7                   Okay. Thank you. Mr. Fourrier?

8           **MR. FOURRIER:**

9                   I'm John Fourrier. I own Fourrier  
10          Consulting Engineers. And I'm a consulting  
11          engineer for three solid waste landfills in  
12          Louisiana.

13          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

14                   All right. Thank you.

15                   At this time I'll entertain a motion to  
16          issue operator certifications for --

17          **MR. WILLIAMS:**

18                   Mr. Chairman?

19          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

20                   Yes, sir.

21          **MR. WILLIAMS:**

22                   Excuse me, sir. I'd like to make a  
23          motion before you continue please. I'd  
24          like to make a motion that expand or amend  
25          the agenda to allow for a representative

1 from the LSWA to come before the Board to  
2 present the workshop agenda and request 10  
3 hours of CEUs?

4 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

5 Okay. We have a motion to expand the  
6 agenda.

7 **MR. BERTHELOT:**

8 Second.

9 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

10 I have a second from Mr. Berthelot.

11 Anyone have any discussion? (No  
12 response.)

13 Anyone have any opposition to expanding  
14 the agenda? (No response.)

15 Hearing none, the motion carries.

16 We'll entertain a report from Ms.  
17 Connie Henry.

18 **MS. HENRY:**

19 Thank you. We have our agenda here, if  
20 you'll take one and pass it down, for each  
21 of you. What we are requesting is 10 hours  
22 for our workshop certification. Our  
23 workshops are in July in Marksville,  
24 Louisiana and October in Shreveport,  
25 Louisiana. We present the minimum 10 hour

1 agenda and when each of you have one I'll  
2 go through it with you.

3 We start on the first day. We have an  
4 Introduction to OSHA which will cover 2  
5 hours; do Fall Protection for another 2  
6 hours. We provide lunch for our  
7 participants. We do an hour of Electrical  
8 Hazards and one hour of Proper Excavation  
9 Procedures. A half-hour of Scaffold Safety  
10 and half-hour of Heavy Equipment Safety.  
11 We conclude for the day at 4:00 p.m.

12 On day 2, we do go back with Personal  
13 Protection Equipment for one hour; Health  
14 Hazards for half an hour; Ladder Hazards  
15 for half an hour; and Fire Protection for  
16 one hour which totals up to 10 hours for  
17 both workshops.

18 We're here to ask for approval for a 10  
19 hour workshop to advertise for continuing  
20 education for attending for both days.

21 **MR. MIZE:**

22 So move.

23 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

24 Okay. We have a move by Mr. Mize.

25 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

1           Second.

2           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

3           Second by Mr. Williams to grant 10  
4           hours of operators continuing education for  
5           the 2 workshops as presented.

6           Any other discussion?

7           **MR. MOLLERE:**

8           Is this all OSHA related?

9           **MS. HENRY:**

10          Yes, sir. So if anyone should choose  
11          to, we will issue a certificate to each of  
12          them. We have a professionally trained  
13          person that's going to come. They'll all  
14          be OSHA certified when they finish and each  
15          one will have the opportunity, if they want  
16          to, to keep their certification. They can  
17          continue each year with 10 more hours of  
18          training whether by us or the facility.

19          **MR. MOLLERE:**

20          Okay. Good.

21          **MS. HENRY:**

22          Yes, sir.

23          **MR. MOLLERE:**

24          So in effect they'll be getting two  
25          certifications?



1           **MS. HENRY:**

2           Correct. They will get their 10 hours  
3           towards their certification as well as OSHA  
4           certification.

5           **MR. MOLLERE:**

6           Thank you.

7           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

8           Very nice. Any other discussion or  
9           questions? (No response.)

10          Hearing none, all in favor signify by  
11          saying by "aye". (All respond.)

12          Any opposed by "nay". (No response.)

13          Motion carries. Thank you, Ms. Henry.

14          **MS. HENRY:**

15          Thank you. Thank you for your time.

16          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

17          Okay. Moving back to our agenda, at  
18          this time I'll entertain a motion to issue  
19          Level A, Operator Certifications to Ms.  
20          Perkins and Mr. Fourrier for Landfill,  
21          Level A; Surface Impoundment, Level A;  
22          Landfarm, Level A; Incinerator/Waste  
23          Handling Facility, Level A; Transfer  
24          Station, Level A; Construction Demolition  
25          and Woodwaste Facility, Level A; Composting

1 Facility, Level A; and Separation Facility,  
2 Level A.

3 **MR. MOLLERE:**

4 Mr. Chairman, I move that they be  
5 certified in all areas.

6 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

7 Second.

8 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

9 Moved by Mr. Mollere and seconded by  
10 Mr. Williams. Any discussion? (No  
11 response.)

12 Any opposition? (No response.)

13 Hearing none, the motion carries.

14 **MR. MOLLERE:**

15 Congratulations.

16 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

17 Congratulations. Next is review of the  
18 minutes of the previous meeting, the  
19 November 30th meeting. Any comments,  
20 questions, or corrections on the minutes?  
21 (No response.)

22 Hearing none, I'll entertain a motion  
23 to approve the minutes.

24 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

25 So move.

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**MR. LAGRANGE:**

So moved by Mr. Williams.

Second.

And these could be because I got so many of these last minute that they just faxed them to me and I'm getting -- I don't have the originals yet.

**MR. WILLIAMS:**

Okay.

**MR. LAGRANGE:**

Well, on Mr. Musgrove it says he's the President so I don't know who he would get -- who would sign for him.

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**MR. WILLIAMS:**

The Board of Directors.

**MR. MOLLERE:**

Mr. Chairman, I also note Ms. Ann Wilson who is probably well known to us on this board, has moved from Alexandria down to New Orleans to Sewage and Water Board. I had several conversations with her here and she's going to be the Environmental Quality person now at the Sewage and Water Board and tested here for her Incinerator. She's quite excited about her new position down there.

**MR. LAGRANGE:**

Okay. Mr. Lyons, we had discussed -- we had one of the applicants get his experience requirements in April or something like that.

**MR. LYONS:**

Yes. Ms. Vicki Crain, she tested and made a 100 on her Level B. Her experience is going to come up for two years on April 25th. Today is the 22nd. So I ask the Board that we go on and grant it on the 25th, her Level B.

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**MR. LAGRANGE:**

The 25th of April?

**MR. LYONS:**

Of April, yes. Of this month.

**MR. LAGRANGE:**

No.

**MS. BORDELON:**

Next month.

**MR. LYONS:**

No. Next month. I'm sorry.

**MR. LAGRANGE:**

Any other comments or questions? (No response.)

I'll entertain a motion to approve these applicants for regular certification with the stipulations discussed previously.

**MR. STEWART:**

So move.

**MR. LAGRANGE:**

Moved by Mr. Stewart.

9 **MS. BORDELON:**

10 No regular conditionals. No  
11 conditionals.

12 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

13 Now we have a request for extension of  
14 conditional certifications. We have Robert  
15 C. Becker, Louisiana State Penitentiary,  
16 Incinerator, Level A. Expires March 25th.

3 This is for a Separation.

4 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

5 Oh, it's a different one.

6 **MS. BORDELON:**

7 It's a different one. She just  
8 received the C & D. She just made two  
9 years so she has a regular C & D but she's  
10 a Level A for the Separation Facility and  
11 so she doesn't have the time.

12 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

13 Gator Environmental, Separation, Level  
14 A. You can note there's three extensions  
15 that were expired prior to our meeting.  
16 And Suzanne and I discussed that. The  
17 appropriate manner is to issue retroactive  
18 to those dates. So I'll entertain a motion  
19 to grant the extension requests.

20 **MR. LYONS:**

21 So moved.

22 **MR. MIZE:**

23 Second.

24 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

25 So moved by Mr. Lyons. Seconded by Mr.

1 Mize. Any other discussion? (No  
2 response.) Any opposition? (No response.)  
3 Motion carries. Thank you.

1           Hearing none, motion carries.

2           We also have an incomplete  
3 certification? Did he send in an  
4 application?

5           **MS. BORDELON:**

6           He's getting -- he'll receive his last  
7 10 hours in Marksville.

8           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

9           Okay. And that's -- when does he  
10 expire? After that?

11          **MS. BORDELON:**

12          It's after that date, yes.

13          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

14          So we're going to wait and approve that  
15 in Marksville?

16          **MS. BORDELON:**

17          You can go ahead and approve it now  
18 contingent upon him attending.

19          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

20          Clatter W. Polidore, Landfill, Level B,  
21 C & D, Level B, St. Mary Parish West End  
22 Solid Waste Transfer Station. I'll  
23 entertain a motion to grant recertification  
24 upon confirmation of completion of his

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**MR. WILLIAMS:**

Move.

**MR. MOLLERE:**

Second.

Moved by Mr. Williams and seconded by Mr. Mollere. Any discussion? (No response.) Any opposition? (No response.) Motion carries.

20 Okay. I'll entertain a motion to issue  
 21 regular certifications to those  
 22 individuals.

23 **MR. LYONS:**

24 So move.

25 **MR. MIZE:**

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Second.

**MR. LAGRANGE:**

Moved by Mr. Lyons and seconded by Mr. Mize. Any discussion? (No response.)

Any opposition? (No response.)

The motion carries.

Next we move in to our Committee reports. We have the Awards Committee, Mr. Mize.

**MR. MIZE:**

I apologize I wasn't here for the awards yesterday but under the circumstances I couldn't make it. I still think we're not getting enough. You know we're only getting As and the Bs and Cs we're not getting any applications for them or any awards at all. We've got one for each one is all we've got. So for as many people as we've got certified, that's not very good odds. Do you all have any ideas on how to improve it, I'm open for it and would like to try it.

**MR. MOLLERE:**

We used to send out a special notice to all of the landfills. I'm wondering if



1 maybe we didn't send the notice to all the  
2 operators letting them know that they would  
3 be eligible for these different awards.

4 **MS. BORDELON:**

5 We do e-mail -- I have e-mail addresses  
6 for most everybody that attended this  
7 conference. That's who pretty well --

8 **MR. MOLLERE:**

9 The Mackey Board, of course they don't  
10 come inside the board. The operators, of  
11 course, we have somebody here who is.

12 **MR. BERTHELOT:**

13 Do you know how many As and Bs we have?

14 **MR. MIZE:**

15 I know we don't probably have a whole  
16 lot of Cs but I know we've got a lot, tons  
17 of As and Bs.

18 **MS. BORDELON:**

19 You mean total number of operators?

20 **MR. BERTHELOT:**

21 Yes.

22 **MS. BORDELON:**

23 Roughly around 400. The numbers have  
24 gone down.

25 **MR. MIZE:**

1           And we only get one of each.

2           **MS. PERKINS:**

3           Is e-mail the only way that you get  
4           this message out?

5           **MS. BORDELON:**

6           It has been. In the past we've mailed  
7           it. I mean that's a big mail out.

8           **MS. PERKINS:**

9           I'm just thinking because I know just  
10          in my regular everyday, some e-mails I look  
11          at and some I'm not even going to open  
12          based on what it says. So maybe people  
13          aren't really seeing what it is and if you  
14          -- how is it worded in the title, calling  
15          it what it is or maybe in the title have  
16          them or instruct them to post it like in  
17          the break rooms that way the people could  
18          be accountable for themselves.

19          Like they can see it. Like people like  
20          praise. So of course if they see that they  
21          can get some kind of award, they read  
22          about, then they'll submit. But a lot of  
23          times, just the everyday dealing on the  
24          landfill is so busy. Sometimes people are  
25          stretched really far with their people so

1           they can't really do that when they're  
2           trying to deal with day-to-day stuff.

3           So just I guess maybe a better way to  
4           let the management know is to post it so  
5           that they can read it for themselves and  
6           then submit and that way you may get a big  
7           turn out.

8           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

9           Other ideas may be to send it out two  
10          or three times, you know, just as a  
11          reminder, reminder.

12          **MS. BORDELON:**

13          We send it out twice.

14          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

15          They do it twice now?

16          **MS. BORDELON:**

17          Yes.

18          **MR. STEWART:**

19          Can we incorporate it into the  
20          conferences or the workshops just kind of  
21          make a big deal about it, hey, look.  
22          Because a lot of people don't know it.

23          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

24          That would probably help.

25          **MR. MOLLERE:**

1           Workshops would be a good area to do  
2           it, maybe even have handout.

3           **MS. PERKINS:**

4           Or a flyer.

5           **MR. BERTHELOT:**

6           That's what I was thinking.

7           **MR. STEWART:**

8           Or give somebody five or ten minutes to  
9           speak on it and just say hey, look, you can  
10          be nominated and receive an award.

11          **MS. BORDELON:**

12          Or maybe we can take nominations all  
13          year up until. Because if we tell them  
14          about it at the July workshop, come  
15          December or January, they're going to  
16          forget about it.

17          **MR. WILLIAMS:**

18          That's a good idea. Do it all year.

19          **MS. BORDELON:**

20          Have nominations open all year.

21          **MR. MOLLERE:**

22          Is there anything preventing us from  
23          doing it all year?

24          **MR. STEWART:**

25          No.

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**MS. BORDELON:**

Excused me?

**MR. MOLLERE:**

I mean we don't have a rule that says we can not.

**MS. BORDELON:**

No. We have a deadline before the conference because that's only so that we can get a committee together to vote and get the plaques made and the books made and everything. But I don't see why we can't at the workshops hand out nomination forms and ask them to get them in and I'll just collect them up until.

**MR. MOLLERE:**

Well let's do that.

**MR. BERTHELOT:**

And try to make it mandatory that they fill them out here so you know you'll get them instead of taking them back home.

**MS. BORDELON:**

Well, no. I don't think we need to because that's a lot of information for them to fill out at a workshop. Plus somebody is supposed to nominate them. You

1 cannot nominate yourself.

2 **MS. PERKINS:**

3 You said that it would be a lot to send  
4 out a lot of mailings. But we do have  
5 these conferences throughout the year.  
6 Everybody gets one of these (showing name  
7 tag). Like when we print these out, print  
8 out like a callout that we're going to have  
9 it on the other side. Everybody gets one  
10 so everybody will have to see it and that  
11 way you only have to print it once.

12 Just kind of like an announcement and  
13 it'll just kind of be in there. Just like  
14 everybody gets a crawfish boil thing.  
15 Everybody knows that's coming. So  
16 everybody has a name badge on the other  
17 side. Just kind of let them know about the  
18 awards that we have on the other side and  
19 then you only have to print it out once it  
20 shouldn't be that much of a cost  
21 difference.

22 **MR. STEWART:**

23 And that's true because at my facility  
24 none of my guys know anything about this.  
25 If they get an award it's because somebody

1           nominated them but they don't know about  
2           this awards process at all. And I'm sure  
3           it's like that everywhere.

4           **MS. PERKINS:**

5                     It's busy at a landfill.

6           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

7                     I think those are some great ideas and  
8           let's start with starting with the  
9           workshops. We'll take a minute and have  
10          someone speak on it and handout some copies  
11          of the application to the attendees and  
12          that'll help hopefully spur a little more  
13          interest in it. And then for the next  
14          conference, as you mentioned, with the name  
15          tag situation, we could also look into  
16          that.

17          **MR. BERTHELOT:**

18                     And if we could also get the word out  
19          to the LSWA Board that this is what we are  
20          recommending that they do.

21          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

22                     Yes. Will you take care of that Mr.  
23          Williams.

24          **MR. WILLIAMS:**

25                     Yes. I think I might be able to get

1 the word out.

2 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

3 Okay. Anything else under awards?

4 **MR. MIZE:**

5 No. Thank you very much.

6 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

7 Any one else have anything under  
8 awards? (No response.)

9 **MR. BERTHELOT:**

10 We had some good winners.

11 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

12 Excellent choices.

13 **MR. STEWART:**

14 And it was unique because it wasn't  
15 just some dozer operator or somebody that  
16 got it. It was actually somebody that put  
17 another contribution into the solid waste  
18 industry. That's the biggest misconception  
19 too about the award.

20 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

21 Testing committee. Mr. Mollere?

22 **MR. MOLLERE:**

23 I tested Wednesday morning next door in  
24 the big dome part. Had 19 test, 17 passed.

25 **MR. BERTHELOT:**



1           Is there any reason why they moved the  
2 test this year?

3           **MS. BORDELON:**

4           Moved the location?

5           **MR. MOLLERE:**

6           Convenient to have the room over there  
7 available. There was a little bit of a  
8 confusion I know of people trying to find  
9 it.

10          **MR. BERTHELOT:**

11          Yes, exactly.

12          **MR. MIZE:**

13          Where was the test?

14          **MS. BORDELON:**

15          It was actually in the Cajun Dome.

16          **MR. MOLLERE:**

17          We were in the Cajun Dome. I don't  
18 know that they had anything available at  
19 that time and why they moved it, I don't  
20 know. But that's where they told us we  
21 were going to have it.

22          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

23          In the past we've had it right  
24 upstairs.

25          **MR. MOLLERE:**

1           It made it a little bit more -- people  
2           were wandering around trying to find where  
3           to go.

4           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

5           Anything else, Mr. Mollere?

6           **MR. MOLLERE:**

7           That's it. Thank you, sir.

8           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

9           Thank you. Continuing Education, Mr.  
10          Berthelot?

11          **MR. BERTHELOT:**

12          The next one is going to be held in  
13          Marksville, July 16th and 17th. And then  
14          Shreveport October 22nd and 23rd.

15          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

16          Any one have any report on this  
17          conference as far as attendees or anything?

18          **MR. MOLLERE:**

19          I don't know if we have a final number.  
20          I think we had 8,000 people at the crawfish  
21          boil. Probably some of the better speakers  
22          that we've had in a while. The attendance  
23          is a little up this year, the exhibits are  
24          little down. But overall we've had some  
25          very positive comments on the conference

1 and people seem to be very pleased.

2 In speaking with the different vendors,  
3 they seem to be pleased with the contacts  
4 that they have come by their booths. And  
5 the folks that were upstairs, I mean we've  
6 had rooms full. We did have the Regional  
7 Administrator for EPA come and was able to  
8 hear the speakers for the preliminary  
9 session, the secretary of DEQ and the  
10 Deputy Secretary and then we had the ethics  
11 speaker again. Some people that were here  
12 had their hour of certification again for  
13 that. And then the luncheon speaker was  
14 the Director of Homeland Security for the  
15 State and probably one of the better  
16 speakers because you could hear every word.  
17 He enunciated. It was very well done. And  
18 of course, you've got the awards at that  
19 point.

20 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

21 Thank you for that report. Next we'll  
22 move on to nominating committee. I think  
23 Mr. Delaney Louis was the Chairman of that.  
24 At this time I'd like to appoint Mr. Fred  
25 Williams as the Chairman of the Nominating

1 Committee going forward. Mr. Williams, do  
2 you have a report?

3 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

4 No, sir.

5 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

6 You'll have a report for the July  
7 meeting?

8 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

9 More than happy to.

10 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

11 Okay. Thank you. Any other business  
12 to come before the Board? Mr. Stewart?

13 **MR. STEWART:**

14 I don't know who I would get to address  
15 this. My nomination back onto this Board  
16 has been since what, October of last year.  
17 She still hasn't received any type of  
18 paperwork. It's been confirmed through a  
19 verbal thing but she doesn't have anything  
20 in writing.

21 **MR. WILLIAMS:**

22 Well you're still a board member.

23 **MR. STEWART:**

24 And I'm not complaining but that's an  
25 ongoing thing.

1           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

2                       So the Police Jury Association  
3                       submitted their recommendation to the  
4                       Secretary?

5           **MS. BORDELON:**

6                       No, they have not. We asked --

7           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

8                       They haven't?

9           **MS. BORDELON:**

10                      No. I submitted -- we submitted a  
11                      letter asking to reappoint him for another  
12                      three years and we have not received  
13                      anything back.

14           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

15                      You submitted that to the Police Jury  
16                      Association?

17           **MS. BORDELON:**

18                      Yes.

19           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

20                      And you haven't received anything back?

21           **MR. STEWART:**

22                      We got a verbal but she has not been  
23                      given anything in writing.

24           **MR. MOLLERE:**

25                      You continue to get your per diem don't

1           you?

2           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

3                    Suzanne, will you e-mail me a copy of  
4           that.

5           **MS. BORDELON:**

6                    Okay.

7           **MR. LAGRANGE:**

8                    I'll try to follow up on that. Thank  
9           you Mr. Stewart.

10          **MR. WILLIAMS:**

11                    You can serve on the Board indefinitely  
12          until you have been officially replaced.  
13          You can serve for ten years as long as you  
14          haven't been replaced.

15          **MR. STEWART:**

16                    Well y'all better get used to me then.

17          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

18                    Any other business? (No response.)

19                    Any public comments? (No response.)

20          **MR. BERTHELOT:**

21                    Move to adjourn.

22          **MR. WILLIAMS:**

23                    Second.

24          **MR. LAGRANGE:**

25                    Move by Mr. Berthelot, seconded by Mr.

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Williams. Any discussion? (No response.)

Any opposition? (No response.)

This meeting is adjourned. Thank you  
all for coming.

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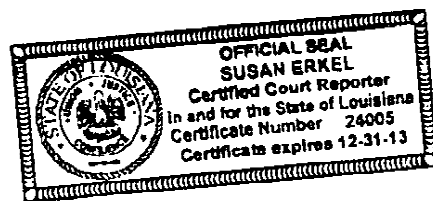
