20 MR. LAGRANGE:

21 First order of business on the
22 agenda is review of the October 16th
23 Minutes of our meeting. Do you have
24 any comments? Questions?

25 MR. MOLLERE:

1 I noticed, Mr. Chairman, in one
2 area where I made the comment about
3 East Baton Rouge Parish. And I think
4 Mr. Guillory -- it's the very end. And
5 somehow it was picked up, I think, as
6 East Feliciana or something. It wasn't
7 Baton Rouge.

8 So it's right towards the end when
9 we were commenting on why Mr. Guillory
10 could not be present. And the comment
11 was made because it was in the middle
12 of the mayoral Campaign. He was having
13 a great deal of appearances for some of
14 the public works areas. It was just
15 one little word. That was the only
16 change. I don't think -- I forget what
17 page number it is. When I read the
18 minutes, I noticed it should say "East
19 Baton Rouge."

20 MR. BERTHOLOT:

21 It should be around Page 18 or 19.

22 MR. LAGRANGE:

23 East Landry Parish, Page 19. So
24 you make a motion to adopt the minutes
25 with the change on Page 19 from East

1 Landry Parish to East Baton Rouge
2 Parish.

3 MR. MOLLERE:

4 So moved.

5 MR. LAGRANGE:

6 Do I have a second?

7 MR. MIZE:

8 Second.

9 MR. LAGRANGE:

10 Seconded by Mr. Mize. Any other
11 discussion? Any opposition? Minutes
12 are approved.

13 Now, we'll move on to the approval
14 of Continuing Education Units or hours
15 for waste conference presented by Ms.
16 Yolanda Righteous of Louisiana Solid
17 Waste Association.

18 (AGENDA ITEM NO. 3)

19 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

20 I think you guys currently have a
21 copy of the agenda in front of you.
22 I'm not going to go through every item
23 on the agenda. The format is pretty
24 much the same as it was from last year.
25 The only difference is we're going to

1 combine some of the air and waste
2 tracks as there is a great deal of

6 You'll see that if you count
7 through the hours, and Connie was kind
8 enough to put the hours off to the
9 side, we counted up 10.5 hours. Now,
10 that includes 1.5 hours for the lunch
11 and the guest speaker. We have the
12 same number of tracks as last year in
13 Solid Waste and Industrial track, the
14 Air Track, the USD Track, and the Water
15 and Waste Water track.

16 MR. MIZE:

17 What is the actual dates? Some of
18 this is not in April. I think it's in
19 March, instead of April.

20 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

21 That is correct. March --

23 March 20 through 22.

25 Connie just mentioned the hours

2 MR. LAGRANGE:

3 Can you go through it?

4 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

5 Yes. That's .5 hours Peggy had,
6 and then an hour for the ethics
7 speaker, .5 hours for Alex, .5 hours
8 for Steve Shutz, an hour and a half for
9 lunch. Then the first session from
10 1:00 to 1:30, that's half hour, 1:30 to
11 2:00, that's a half hour. And all the
12 way down the first day, that's a half
13 an hour. And then from 4:00 to 5:00,
14 that's an additional hour. Going into
15 the second day right before the
16 exhibitor visitation break, you have an
17 hour. And then two hours after the
18 exhibitor visitation.

19 I think that's 10 hours. So what
20 you may be looking at is 10 hours and
21 not 10 ½

8 Administrator Ron Curry. Do you have
9 any thoughts on maybe the new EPA
10 Administrator?

15 I think he's been named. Ron
16 Curry.

17 MR. MOLLERE:

18 Oh, okay. That was the acting. Is
19 he going to be permanent?

20 MS. RIGHTEOUS:

21 That's what I assume.

22 MR. MOLLERE:

23 I will double-check with my contact
24 over there and find out. David Gray
25 has been the administrative person that

1 I've talked to about the RA's chief
2 assistant. So I'll check with him and
3 make sure we get that.

4 MR. LAGRANGE:

5 Anyone have any other questions
6 concerning the proposed agenda and
7 granting ten education hours?

8 MR. BERTHOLOT:

9 Move to allow.

10 MR. WILLIAMS:

11 Second.

7 questions, comments, or discussion?

10 and his year and a half at the
11 landfill. Anyone have any questions
12 relative to that?

13 We move on to the next one. Ronald
14 J. Edwards, St. Landry Parish Solid
15 Waste Disposal District, Landfill Level
16 B. Any comments? Questions?

17 Next is Susan E. Helmer, West
18 Carroll Parish Police Jury, West
19 Carroll Parish Sanitary Landfill,
20 Landfill Level A. Any questions or
21 comments?

22 Next is Henry K. Horton, St. Landry
23 Parish Solid Waste Disposal District,
24 St. Landry Parish Solid Waste Landfill,
25 Landfill Level B.

1 Next is Lena Munholland, Northeast
2 Construction Company, Inc., for a
3 Separation Facility Level A.

4 Suzanne, is this one of the new
5 facilities that made classified?

6 MS. BORDELON:

7 Yes, it is.

8 MR. LAGRANGE:

9 And this is for what type of --

10 MS. BORDELON:

11 It's for air certain destructor.

12 MR. MOLLERE:

13 Susan, is that out there by --

14 MS. BORDELON:

15 I'm not sure where it is.

16 MR. MOLLERE:

17 -- off of I-20. I think they put
18 one in out there.

19 MR. LAGRANGE:

20 Any questions or comments on Ms.
21 Munholland's application?

22 Next we have Mr. Tony Munholland,
23 Northeast Construction for a Separation
24 Facility Level B.

25 MR. MOLLERE:

1 They have a family operation?

2 MS. BORDELON:

3 Yes.

4 MR. LAGRANGE:

5 Next we have Clay J. Naquin,

6 Terrebonne Parish Consolidated

7 Government, Ashland Landfill, for a

8 Landfill Level A.

9 MS. BORDELON:

10 He would have held conditional

11 certificates for three years in

12 February. And he's requesting regular

13 certification now.

14 MR. LAGRANGE:

15 Once he meets his, at that point?

16 MS. BORDELON:

17 At that point, yes.

18 MR. MIZE:

19 He passed the test a long time ago,

20 right?

21 MS. BORDELON:

22 Oh, yeah. He passed the test three

23 years ago.

24 MR. LAGRANGE:

25 Any other comments on Mr. Naquin?

1 MS. BORDELON:

2 If we can go back to Mr. Naquin and
3 maybe see if we can make it effective
4 end of January because his conditional
5 expires January 27 to begin January,
6 right.

7 MR. LAGRANGE:

8 Next we have Lonnie R. Veal, St.
9 Landry Parish South Waste Disposal
10 District, for a Landfill Level B. I
11 see they have about three applicants,
12 and their positions are relief
13 operators. Does anyone know anything
14 about a relief operator versus a
15 regular operator?

16 MR. MOLLERE:

17 That's what I was looking at. I
18 was wondering what they qualify
19 classified relief operator. They work
20 with Herman Rouse. So I'm sure he
21 doesn't let them slouch.

22 MR. LAGRANGE:

23 Any other questions, comments on
24 Mr. Veal? Hearing none, I will
25 entertain a motion to approve the

1 applications for certifications.

2 Moved by Mr. Mollere. Seconded by
3 Mr. Williams. Any other discussion?
4 Any opposition? Motion carries.

4 Next we'll go to issuance of
5 operator's certificates. Ms. Bordelon.

6 MS. BORDELON:

7 Marshall Brancroft, Landfill Level
8 A, Keith Frederick, Landfill Level B,
9 Susan Helmer, Landfill Level A, Lena
10 Joe Munholland, Separation Level A,
11 Tony Munholland, Separation Level B,
12 Clay Naquin, Landfill Level A.

13 MR. LAGRANGE:

14 Moved by Mr. Mollere, Seconded by
15 Mr. Mize to issue operator's
16 certificates. Any other discussion?
17 Any opposition? Motion carries.

18 (AGENDA ITEM NO. 5)

19 MR. LAGRANGE:

20 Now we move into Committee Reports.
21 First, we have Awards Committee, Mr.
22 Mize.

23 MR. MIZE:

24 (Inaudible) is going to send him
25 out in January to everybody, and

1 hopefully we'll get some response back.
2 this year. We haven't done too good
3 last three years.

4 MR. MOLLERE:

5 Mr. Chairman, I think we really
6 ought to ask all members of our Board
7 to promote the A&B, particularly the B,
8 because I don't think they've been
9 getting a great deal of participation
10 there. There's some really qualified
11 people out there very dedicated to the
12 profession.

13 MR. LAGRANGE:

14 I agree. Suzanne, when you send
15 out, keep reiterating and hopefully get
16 some good applicants for consideration.

17 Testing. Mr. Mollere.

18 MR. MOLLERE:

19 Mr. Chairman, no one tested today.
20 So everybody passed.

21 MR. LAGRANGE:

22 But you did have some come to the
23 office?

24 MS. BORDELON:

25 I have three people, actually, four

1 that tested this past week.

2 MR. MOLLERE:

3 They took it onsite.

4 MR. LAGRANGE:

5 Continuing education. Mr.
6 Bertholot.

7 MR. BERTHOLOT:

8 We'll have our Continuing Education
9 Waste Conference in Lafayette, March
10 the 20th through the 22nd.

11 MR. LAGRANGE:

12 Nominating Committee. Mr. Delaney
13 Lewis. He's with the Nominating
14 Committee. He did call this morning to
15 advise that his term has expired in
16 October. And due to work schedule and
17 business constraints, that he will not
18 seek to be reappointed for a second
19 three-year term. So we will have a
20 need to provide a nominee, which his
21 spot was for private industry.

22 Suzanne, do you want to comment on
23 any others?

24 MS. BORDELON:

25 We have Terrance. He has still yet

1 to be reappointed for another three-
2 year term. I've drafted his letter and
3 will wait on a response for that one as
4 well as David Guillory with LMA.

5 MR. LAGRANGE:

6 Any other questions or comments?

7 MR. WILLIAMS:

8 We had talked at one time about
9 persons who miss some of our meetings
10 and whether or not they should remain
11 on the Board.

12 Did we ever come to a conclusion on
13 that discussion?

14 MS. BORDELON:

15 No.

16 MR. LAGRANGE:

17 No, we didn't because there's
18 nothing in the regs to my knowledge
19 that addresses that issue. In order to
20 really address it, I think you would
21 need to amend something into the rules
22 and regulations relative to that.

23 For instance, with the parish
24 government, we appoint members to all
25 types of boards and commissions. And

1 we have an ordinance in place that
 2 requires that when a board member
 3 misses three consecutive monthly
 4 meetings, that the parish council be
 5 notified. And then we contact that
 6 member and say, hey, you missed three
 7 consecutive meetings. Is there a
 8 problem? Are you still continuing to
 9 want to serve? Typically, once you
 10 make that contact, they either realize
 11 hey, I don't have time to serve so I'm
 12 going to resign, or they start
 13 attending the meetings.

14 Very, very seldom do we have to,
 15 the council have to take action to
 16 actually involuntarily replace someone
 17 for failure to attend meetings.

18 So something similar would probably
 19 have to be amended into the regs to
 20 address that absenteeism of board
 21 members at our meetings.

22 MR. BERTHOLOT:

23 And how would we go about that?

24 MR. LAGRANGE:

25 That would probably need to make a

1 formal request to DEQ to consider doing
2 that. Would that be an appropriate
3 process?

4 MR. MOLLERE:

5 Of course it would take public
6 hearings and publication in the
7 register and all that process.

8 MR. LAGRANGE:

9 So it may be better just to
10 hopefully seek out and solicit future
11 nominees for the Board that really, you
12 know, willing and able to make the
13 commitment.

14 MR. WILLIAMS:

15 Well, I guess in certain instances,
16 we can contact the nominating body to
17 make them aware about the person they
18 nominated.

19 MR. LAGRANGE:

20 That's correct. That's also
21 another option to make them aware that
22 the nominating body is aware that the
23 folks who were nominated and appointed
24 to the Board to represent their them is
25 not attending meetings; therefore,

1 they're not getting the proper
2 representation they should be getting
3 by the Board.

4 That's also another avenue that we
5 can take, wither it's Louisiana
6 Municipal Association, Police Jury
7 Association, private industry,
8 professional organizations, whatever.

9 MR. MOLLERE:

10 At one point, I think we had talked
11 about. Because private industry taking
12 over more of the landfills, it's
13 actually one representative from LMA
14 and one from police jury and making
15 those private industries to two from
16 LMA, two from police jury, and have
17 four from private industry.

18 And I think when we got to
19 discussing that, we decided that would
20 probably not be the best thing to do
21 because we needed that input from our
22 governmental agencies.

23 MR. LAGRANGE:

24 Suzanne, you'll report back on once
25 you send those nominating letters and

1 what we have.

2 (AGENDA ITEM NO. 8)

3 Any other business come before the
4 Board today?

5 MR. MOLLERE:

6 There are some distinguished guests
7 with us.

8 (AGENDA ITEM NO. 9)

9 MR. LAGRANGE:

10 Under public comment, we'd like to
11 recognize our distinguished guests here
12 with us. First, we have Ms. Yolanda
13 Righteous with us. We have Ms. Connie
14 Henry from Terrebonne Parish, I mean,
15 Tangipahoa Parish, excuse me. And
16 welcome you here. And also with the
17 Louisiana Solid Waste Association
18 Board, Mr. Rodney Schamerhorn, as well,
19 with Louisiana Solid Waste Association
20 Board. And we have two gentlemen, a
21 former board member, Mr. Norrish
22 Crappell, St. Mary Parish, retired from
23 St. Mary Parish Landfill. And current
24 Harold J. "Babe" Landry Landfill
25 supervisor, Mr. Donovan Driskle. We


