And then we've had a lot of recent announcements, and I'll go through those with you. We've had a lot of really good announcements. We have the Canadian-based IDSI that's currently headquartered in Calgary, Alberta that's going to be locating its manufacturing and service center in the Louisiana Immersive Technologies Enterprise Facility, which is on the ULL Campus in Lafayette. They are a logging-tool manufacturing project and will result in nearly 40 new direct and indirect jobs.

We have Plastipak Packaging announced it's manufacturer expansion in Pineville and they'll invest \$9-million and they'll add three new PET plastic production lines resulting in about 58 new direct and indirect jobs.

And Brown & Root announced the establishment of their corporate headquarters here in Baton Rouge, and if you've seen it, along I10, I think they put their banner on the building. So they're an industrial firm that's going to be operating

newly-acquired -- will operate newly-acquired assets in Brown & Root and Wink Engineering and that will have initially 350 new jobs here in Louisiana and they'll have potentially 575 future jobs here in the state.

And Cajo Technologies announced the selection of New Orleans for the company's first U.S. manufacturing plant and they are a finishing manufacturer and they'll result in about 80 new direct and indirect jobs.

And Investimus Foris announced a \$265-million ammonia plant in Grant Parish, and that will result in about 85 new direct jobs and about 584 new indirect jobs. And it's at the former Vanguard Synfuels site.

And Florida Fuel Connection announced a \$75-million capital investment here in Louisiana as a rail terminal project and that's a pipeline-to-rail project and that will include about 50 new direct jobs in East Feliciana Parish with about 137 new indirect jobs.

And, also, there were some recent rankings that were announced since we last met. We were recognized -- the State of Louisiana was recognized as Thumbtack.com's annual ranking, and we received a grade of "A" on their 2015 Report Card for Small Business

1	Friendliness, and we were ranked in the State Number 4			
2	in the US for it's support of small business			
3	environment. Louisiana earned an "A" in eight specific			
4	categories of the State Small Business Climate, and a

6	just so you know, is ranked among the top five states in			
7	Thumbtack.com's survey for three of the past four years.			
8	And, also, LED FastStart, which has held			
9	the rank of Number 1 for the Nation's Workforce Training

11	it's an unprecedented six years now in a row. So
