20	covers those topics, so a great milestone reached and
21	very exciting for the State.
22	In addition, LED FastStart, Louisiana's
23	customized workforce development program, earned the

excited about that recognition.

These rankings are part of Business
Facilities' 2014 State Records Report. They issue this report annually to gauge competitiveness of state economic programs and indicators across the nation.
Louisiana was recognized in a number of other categories as well, in particular, recognized as Number 2 for Export Leaders and Number 3 for Economic Growth Potential.

Louisiana made it's initial appearance in the top 10 at Number 8 in 2010, and since that time, we've made steady progress in reaching Number 1 this year. As part of that report recognition, the magazine commented on Louisiana's first time first place ranking, and I just wanted to read the comment. "Pick a successful growth strategy other states are starting to replicate, and you'll discover that Louisiana has made it work on a grand scale. Nowhere is this more evident than in the unprecedented corporation between higher education resources and business in Louisiana." So we're excited to be recognized for our efforts and we're certainly excited that Business Facilities recognized the work that's going on in the state and we're very pleased with that recognition.

So Louisiana now ranks higher in every

national business climate ranking than it ever did prior to 2008, and those include publications by Business Facilities, who I just mentioned, Area Development, Beacon Hill Institute, Chief Executive, CNBC, Forbes, Pollina Corporate Real Estate and Site Selection. four of those national business climate rankings, we now rank in the top 10 states in the U.S., including being recognized by the Business Facilities as the Number 1 Business Climate in the U.S.. So some great progress along that front and some great recognition, and this recognition is based on a whole host of factors, including efforts within the department, but also the overall performance of the economy, the reforms that have taken place over the last several years and a variety of other factors. So great for the State to receive that recognition.

The second thing I wanted to comment on was Louisiana Job Connection. At our last Board meeting, we had a presentation on Louisiana Job Connection, which is a new online system for matching job seekers with companies that are hiring, and on the 18th of this month, we launched the system for job seekers. We had already been cultivating employers and getting them familiar with the system, having them post jobs and signing up for the system, so we were able to

launch the system for job seekers just last week. The skills-base matching platform automatically matches job seekers with jobs which they're most qualified and has a number of automated features and advanced messaging features to enhance the job seeking experience for both employers and applicants, recognizing the growth in Louisiana economy, the job opportunities that are associated with a number of projects that are on the LBA, along with numerous partners across the horizon. state are making conservative effort to work towards meeting those workforce opportunities in the near term. More than 600 Louisiana employers are already participating on the Louisiana Job Connection, and on the first day, 700 job seekers signed up for the site and started participating on that online matching, so overall, the initial launch is going quite well. We continue to seek both employers and job applicants or job seekers to sign up. We're, again, excited about the system, excited about the launch. We want to continue that momentum and leverage that as a unique resource that Louisiana offers to any existing business in the state.

The system is modeled off of some of the work we have been doing with LED FastStart. LED FastStart and the work that was done with the program,

LED FastStart was producing these types of functionalities for a number of its clients, a number of companies that have looked in the state for investing, and we decided to essentially augment the platform and build it with a common interface and now offer that to any employer across the state. So a great initial launch, and we look forward to continued success with Louisiana Job Connection.

The final effort I want to mention was the new LSU Transformational Technology and Cyber Research Center, which was announced earlier this March, and this is an example of the partnership between higher education and the State. This particular partnership is focused on attracting major federal and commercial research projects and apply technology fields and the target for the new center is raising 34.5-million in these types of projects over the next three years. Thirty-million is targeted from external federal or private sources that are seeking the applied technology research projects and would involve a match of 3-million from the State and 1.5-million from LSU. The center is expected to collaborate with Stephenson Disaster Management Institute and other LSU research entities, and the research center's first director, Jeff Moulton,

comes to LSU from Georgia Tech Research Institute, where he served as the Director of Program Development of a 1,700-person entity that attracts more than \$300-million in annual research and development contracts.
