Welcome:

Dr. Dana Hunter, Children's Cabinet Executive Director, welcomed members and guests to the January 14th Children's Cabinet Advisory Board Meeting.

Call to Order:

Kathleen Richey, Children's Cabinet Advisory Board (CCAB) Chair, called the meeting to order and introductions were made.

Roll Call:

Roll was called and a quorum was determined present.

Approval of Minutes:

The minutes for the Dec. 16 meeting were adopted on a motion made by Sue Catching and seconded by Marsha Shuler.

Review Budget Priority Submission:

The board reaffirmed its list of priorities that will be submitted to the Governor's Children's Cabinet. The initiatives include additional funding for early childhood education, a statewide perinatal, infant and early childhood mental health consultation program, strategic planning for Family First Prevention Services Act implementation, and expansion of food services programs for at-risk children.

Emphasis should be placed on the needs of the whole child.

Family First Prevention Services Act Presentation:

Department of Children and Family Services representative Dr. Rhenda Hodnett did a presentation on the federal Family First Prevention Services Act. She gave an overview of the law which requires states to focus on early intervention to keep children in families. Foster care is used as a temporary intervention under Family First. The law passed by Congress in 2018 goes into effect in October 2021.

Fifty percent of children in foster care are under age 5 and approximately 25 percent are teenagers. Under the new law, Title IV-E funds can be used for prevention services such as mental health and substance abuse treatment, in-home parenting skills, kinship navigation. That was not previously allowed.

There is a 14-day limit on placement of children in non-medical group homes where previously there was no limit. States will have to pick up the cost of any placement beyond 14 days which can run \$150 a day.

Strategic direction of CCAB Discussion

Dr. Hunter mentioned that there was discussion at the last CCAB meeting about the subject areas of the board's subcommittees and whether they need to be altered in any way.

Kathleen Richey suggested that each subcommittee meet and make recommendations of potential changes. Libbie Sonnier-Netto suggested combining or at least having joint conversations between Early Experience and Early Learning Literacy groups.

Dr. Hunter asked the board for suggestions about future potential presentations members would be interested in. Topics mentioned included the U.S. Census, legislative policy and budget presentations as well as one on ACES.
