The permission to utilize the nebulized medication route of administration at the EMR in the SOP is tied to the following Medical Director Approved Medications:

- Use of Inhaled metered dose nebulizer for beta agonist bronchodilator and anticholinergic for dyspnea/ wheezing: limited to Patients own prescribed medication.
- Inhaled: Opioid Antagonist for Suspected Opioid Overdose. It is the opinion of the LA Emergency Medical Services Certification Commission that EMR providers cannot carry and administer albuterol and Atrovent nebulized medication except within parameters listed within the scope of practice that listed above.; Motion Chris Mixon; 2nd Jeff Watson; motion carried
