14	Yes, sir.
15	MR. RUIZ:
16	Before we question them, can we swear those two in?
17	(Mr. Coleman and Mr. Tyson were sworn.)
18	MR. RUIZ:
19	Okay. The reason we deferred it was because it
20	specifically says mechanics in the State statute does not
21	receive supplemental pay.
22	Chief, can you tell me the duties of this gentleman?
23	MR. TYSON:
24	Yes, sir. He was hired as a mechanic/firefighter. We
25	required him to get a firefighter certification, which he did.

It also means he is a driver and pump operator. In our 1 department, we are pretty short staffed. I have a --2 including myself, 13 total. It's volunteer, and I guess, just 3 4 like everybody else around the country, it's dropped. 5 came on as chief about a year and a half ago, and I was making it to where I wanted all my people, all titles, to be able to 6 7 do anything. So that is why we addressed it as mechanic/firefighter. He is a mechanic, but when the tone 8 9 goes off, his SOG right now is to jump in the pump and --10 MR. RUIZ: He's a pump operator? 11 12 MR. TYSON: Yes, sir, and he has fought fires, but that is his first 13 14 SOG. 15 MR. RUIZ: You all heard his case. 16 17 MR. TYSON: 18 Do you have the list of the runs he has made? MS. ROBERTS: 19 20 I don't think. 21 MR. TYSON: 22 We brought it with us. I don't know if you've got --2.3 MR. COTTEN: 24 I would like to see that, Chief. 25 MR. ROBICHAUX:

5	Do you have him on your roster as a PRF (phonetic)?

12	This year, we are probably looking at close to 800, this
13	year. We average maybe two structure fires a month, average,
14	a lot of MVAs and extrication, and, of course, Chief Cotten
15	knows the brush fires are getting a little crazy here, so
16	MR. COTTEN:
17	What is his regular working hours?
18	MR. TYSON:
19	He is on 8:00 to 5:00.
20	MR. COTTEN:
21	Does he ever work shift?
22	MR. COLEMAN:
23	I have before, yes.
24	MR. TYSON:
25	He it has been a while, but he has done that, yes.

PRICE: 11 Everything before July 1st. 12 MS. ROBERTS: 13 It is going to be \$2,500 that we owe you in back pay 14 money, okay? 15 MR. COLEMAN: 16 17 Okay. 18 MS. ROBERTS: So your first check is only going to be \$1,000, just be 19 aware you will get it. It will be included -- once it gets 20 approved, it will be included with your first -- whatever 21 check that happens to be. 22 MR. COLEMAN: 23 24 Okay.

12	swear Ms. Jones in? The chief has already been sworn.
13	(Ms. Jones was sworn.)
14	MR. TYSON:
15	Would the Board like for me to explain that one, also?

19	Would you like me to explain that one, also?
20	MR. SCHILLACE:
21	You are the chief for Ms. Jones?

1 MR. TYSON: Like I was telling you all before, when I came on, I 2 3 wanted to get all my people to where they could do everything, so Twilla, along with, she is our secretary, but she also -- I 4 made her -- had her -- didn't make, had her get Firefighter I. 5 She has her pump ops, and her SOGs, I usually try and get her 6 as a safety officer, rehab or something, if it is that type of 7 8 call. Otherwise, it is -- like I say, I use her as I need Wildfires, she can go and drive a brush truck. 9 she works those, too. We're all the same. 10 MR. SCHILLACE: 11 Does she have a Civil Service classification? 12 13 MR. TYSON: That is the one we put as an administrative 14 15 assistant/firefighter is what we were going to -- when we go 16 to turn it into the Civil Service Board, and I don't remember 17 who --18 MR. RUIZ: So you all are in the process of applying for the Civil 19 20 Service? 21 MR. TYSON: 22 Yes, sir. Yes, sir. 23 MR. ROBICHAUX: The only problem I see is that nowhere in the stuff that 24 25 you submitted to us, it says anything other than her being a

20	well, they're on the line.

I haven't ever had that, so I don't know what they are. 1 MR. PRICE: 2 There are only two departments in the state that have 3 drivers, one is Alexandria and one is Shreveport. It just so 4 happens that Shreveport has got theirs, and the captains are 5 driving the cars. 6 MR. COTTEN: 7 It is a position that they move to -- they call 8 them DSOs, district safety officers, and, of course, they are 9 a captain's position and they will promote into that position, 10 and they work there for a period, and then they will, you 11 12 know, go on to other assignments. MR. PRICE: 13 It sounds like a good position to have. 14 MR. SCHILLACE: 15 So this particular case, he's coming through the ranks, 16 17 or this is a --18 MS. ROBERTS: 19 He doesn't list any prior service. Because I did run his social, but, see, we had a purge a few years ago, so if he was 20 out, you know, for a while, his name wouldn't be in our 21 22 system. 23 MR. RUIZ: Where is Benton at? 24

RUIZ: So all we're here to do really is to approve them as a 16 17 new district? MS. ROBERTS: 18 19 For me to be able to add them. There is someone that has 20 never been in our system. 21 MR. COTTEN: 22 And I think they have been approved as District 7 around 23 that area up there. MR. SCHILLACE: 24 The only one I see is a fire chief. They have a fire 25
