## Director's Report:

Mr. Rankins gave the following updates:
The Citrus Commodity Survey has been completed, including a blitz of Tangipahoa parish. Sudden Oak Death inspections have been completed for the spring. The Forest Pest Survey has begun with 14 locations statewide. Emerald Ash Borer has been confirmed in Bienville, Morehouse, Jackson, and Ouachita parishes, bringing the total to 9 parishes. Removal of trees with HLB is ongoing. A mobile app is being created to allow users to search the Horticulture
database and submit complaints against contractors. Our assistant director and two inspectors will be attending the Horticulture Inspection Society- Southern Chapter Annual Meeting and Training in Mississippi in September. The director and quarantine coordinator will be attending the National Plant Board meetings in Georgia this month.

## PUBLIC COMMENTS

Mr. Mayes asked a question regarding licensees whom do not meet practice standards and civil matters. There was a discussion of this matter. Mr. Bass took a moment to thank the commission members and inspectors for the good job that they do.
