NEW BUSINESS

Director's Update

Mr. Hardy gave the following updates:

Our Division is busy developing an Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) Response Plan in an attempt to prepare for the anticipated arrival of this insect pest in Louisiana. EAB was confirmed in six Arkansas counties this summer and we expect it to be found in our state in 2015. A federal quarantine will be implemented if/when EAB is found, restricting the movement of firewood and ash nursery stock from infested areas.

Brett Laird, Division employee and LDAF Cooperative Ag Pest Survey (CAPS) Coordinator received a national CAPS award from USDA in July for his continuing service in the federal CAPS program. Brett was one of only three individuals to receive this award.

Mr. Rankins returned last week from the CLARB annual meeting held at CLARB headquarters in Reston, Virginia.

Mr. Hardy will be giving a presentation next week to the 2016 Class of the LSU AgCenter Ag Leadership Program, covering regulatory concepts, pest surveys and the future of insect pests in Louisiana. The Ag Leadership Program is a prestigious two-year curriculum for active and involved members of the ag community statewide, designed to develop leadership skills. The program includes an overseas trip for class participants.

Redbay ambrosia beetle, present in the SE US since 2002 and known as the vector of the lethal laurel wilt fungus affecting laurel tree species, sassafras and avocado, was confirmed in north Louisiana in September 2014. The fungus spreads through natural beetle movement and via human-assisted transport of infected wood / chips.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments but Mr. Bass took a moment to thank the staff and the commission for the great job that they do and Mr. Parker introduced new inspectors Girvus Johnson and Peter Klingelhofer to the commission members.

Mr. Rankins mentioned that he would like to discuss increasing fines before the next legislative session. Mr. Parker said that they would have something to present at the next commission meeting. Mr. Rankins also mentioned that the commission may want to consider a change in the law to allow them to refuse to issue a license to any individual owing fees or fines to the commission.
