
MINUTES

MEETING

FEBRUARY 22, 2010  
BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA

1. Call to Order - The meeting of the Medical Psychology Advisory Committee (MPAC) of the Louisiana State Board of Medical Examiners, pursuant to lawful notice, was duly convened and called to order at 9:10 a.m., Monday February 22, 2010, at the offices of the Louisiana State Medical Society, Baton Rouge Louisiana.
2. Attendance - MPAC Members were present as follows: Glenn A. Ally PhD, MP, Anita Kablinger, MD, Warren C. Lowe PhD MP, Robert Marier MD ex officio (executive director LSBME), and James Quillin PhD MP.
3. Approval of prior meeting minutes – The minutes of the meeting of January 5, 2010 were reviewed and corrections recommended.
4. Approval of the minutes of the prior executive session meeting was deferred pending correction.
5. Review of proposed rule relating to the practice of medical psychology – A revised draft of the rule was presented to the MPAC for review. A revised draft will be considered at the next meeting of the MPAC for final review and approval.
6. Review of Applications for Advanced Practice – Upon motion and duly seconded, the MPAC moved into Executive Session. Voice vote: unanimous in favor. The MPAC moved into executive session to consider eight applicants for advanced practice.
7. Applications – Having considered applications for advanced practice, motion was made and duly seconded to move the MPAC to regular session. Voice Vote: unanimous in favor. Upon motion and duly seconded, the MPAC voted favorably on seven applicants and voted to defer action on one applicant pending further information. Voice vote: unanimous
8. New business - There was discussion regarding meeting the requirements for continuing education and continuing medical education during this initial phase of license renewal.
9. Dr. Marier informed the MPAC of the LSBME's website and the availability of the website for use by the MPAC in providing pertinent information. For example, the website could be used for a "Frequently Asked Questions" informative page or other material.
10. Adjournment - Upon motion made, duly seconded and passed by unanimous voice vote, the meeting adjourned at 1:00 p.m., on Monday, February 22, 2010.
