- 3. **L14-014 Orleans Parish, City of New Orleans** 4.20 mills tax, 50 years, 2015-2064, acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining or operating works of public improvement of the Audubon Commission.
- 4. **L14-020 Orleans Parish, City of New Orleans -** Authorization of an additional homestead exemption for certain disabled veterans and surviving spouses.
