2. Approval of the minutes of the December 15, 2022 meeting.

Local Governmental Units - Elections (April 29, 2023)

3. L23-008 - Calcasieu Parish, Recreation District No. 1, Ward 3

5.50 mills tax, 10 years, 2025-2034, maintaining and operating recreation facilities, including both movable and immovable property.

4. L23-003 - Natchitoches Parish, Hospital Service District

5.31 mills tax, 10 years, 2023-2032, constructing, operating and maintaining hospital facilities that provide ambulance services.

Local Political Subdivisions - Cash Flow Borrowings

5. L23-009 - Grant Parish Law Enforcement District

Not exceeding \$500,000 Certificates of Indebtedness, not exceeding 3.6%, mature no later than February 1, 2024, current expenses.

6. L23-004 - Tensas Parish Police Jury

Not exceeding \$400,000 Revenue Anticipation Notes, not exceeding 5.5%, mature no later than March 1, 2024, current expenses.

<u>Local Political Subdivisions - Bonds - Final Approval</u>

7. L23-006 - Jefferson Parish Council (DNR Revolving Loan Program)

Not exceeding \$1,400,000 Taxable Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 2.5%, not exceeding 10 years, energy efficiency upgrades and improvements to lighting at the Bonnabel Greenway in Jefferson Parish Council District 5.

8. L23-010 - Jefferson Parish School Board

Not exceeding \$5,200,000 Limited Tax Bonds, not exceeding 6%, not exceeding 20 years, capital expenditures for school purposes, including certain capital costs of the Discovery Arts and Athletic Performance Center.

9. L23-005 - Livingston Parish, Town of Livingston

Not exceeding \$2,000,000 Utility Systems Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 6%, not exceeding 30 years, (1) acquiring, constructing, extending and improving the utility systems and (2) funding a debt service reserve fund, if necessary.

10. L23-001 - Sabine Parish, Waterworks District No. 1 (LDH Program)

Not exceeding \$1,000,000 Taxable Excess Revenues Bond, non-interest bearing, not exceeding 10 years, constructing and acquiring improvements, extensions and replacements to the drinking water system, including equipment, fixtures and accessories.

11. L23-011 - Tangipahoa Parish, Town of Amite City (DEQ Project)

Not exceeding \$25,000,000 Taxable Utilities Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 0.95%, not exceeding 30 years, construct, improve and extend the sewer portion of the System, including the purchase of equipment.

Local Political Subdivisions - Refinancings

12. L23-007 - Caddo Parish Fire District No. 1

Not exceeding \$583,000 Revenue Refunding Certificates, not exceeding 4.5%, not exceeding 10 years, refunding Certificate of Indebtedness, Series 2011.

Public Trust - Final Approval

13. S23-001 - Louisiana Public Facilities Authority (Chevron U.S.A. Inc. Project)

Not exceeding \$900,000,000 Revenue Bonds (Volume Cap), not exceeding 10% tax-exempt or not exceeding 12% taxable, not exceeding 40 years, (1) acquiring, constructing, developing and equipping a renewable diesel production facility located in Geismar, (2) funding reserve funds, if necessary and (3) paying capitalized interest.

14. S23-002 - Louisiana Public Facilities Authority (Loyola University Project)

Not exceeding \$155,000,000 Revenue and Refunding Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 7% tax-exempt or 7.5% taxable, not exceeding 35 years, (1) approximately \$149,445,000 Revenue Bonds, financing or refinancing (a) capital improvements related to a new residence facility located on the site of Mercy Hall, (b) capital improvements and equipment throughout the campuses of the University and (c) other related expenditures including capitalized interest, (2) approximately \$5,555,000 Refunding Revenue Bonds, refunding Revenue Bonds, Series 2011, Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2017 and Revenue and Refunding Revenue Bonds, Series 2021 and (3) funding a debt service reserve, if required.
