- 15. **L15-136 St. Bernard Parish Council (DHH Program) -** Not exceeding \$21,000,000 Taxable Utilities Revenue Bonds, in one or more series, not exceeding 3.45%, not exceeding 22 years, constructing and acquiring additions, extensions and improvements to the water portion of the combined water and sewer system.
