### 3. L22-087 - Orleans Parish, City of New Orleans, Lake Oaks Subdivision Improvement District

Not exceeding \$400 parcel fee, 4 years, 2023-2026, promoting and encouraging the beautification, security and overall betterment.

### Local Political Subdivisions - Cash Flow Borrowings

### 4. L22-089 - St. Mary Parish, City of Morgan City

Not exceeding \$1,500,000 Revenue Anticipation Notes, not exceeding 5%, mature no later than March 31, 2023, current expenses.

### 5. L22-098 - Franklin Parish, Hospital Service District No.1

Not exceeding \$1,500,000 Certificates of Indebtedness, not exceeding 6%, not exceeding 13 months, current expenses.

### 6. L22-090 - West Carroll Parish Law Enforcement District

Not exceeding \$300,000 Promissory Note, not exceeding 2.25%, mature no later than June 30, 2023, current operations.

### Local Political Subdivisions - Community Disaster Loan Program

### 7. L22-086 - Jefferson Parish, Town of Jean Lafitte

Not exceeding \$364,750 Promissory Note (CDL Program), not exceeding 3.5%, not exceeding 5 years, current operations.

# Local Political Subdivisions - Bonds - Final Approval

# 8. L22-099 - East Baton Rouge Parish, Hospital Service District No. 1 (Lane Regional Medical Center Project)

(1) Not exceeding \$92,000,000 Hospital Revenue Bonds, approximately \$14,905,000 refunding bonds and approximately \$76,425,000 revenue bonds, not exceeding 7% fixed or 12% variable rate, not exceeding 30 years or not exceeding 40 years if bonds are sold to a governmental agency of the United States, (a) acquire, construct and equip capital improvements including, but not limited to, (i) construction of an approximately 125,265 square foot, four-story patient tower with a new operating suite and 48 patient rooms and (ii) renovation of the existing lobby and ground floor, (b) refunding Hospital Revenue and Refunding Bonds, Series 2013A and 2013B, (c) funding capitalized interest and (d) funding reserve funds, if required, and (2) not exceeding \$92,000,000 Bond Anticipation Notes, not exceeding 7% fixed or 12% variable rate, not exceeding 4 years, interim financing.

### 9. L22-096 - Iberia Parish, Fire Protection District No. 1

Not exceeding \$1,200,000 Limited Tax Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 4%, mature no later than March 1, 2031, acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating fire protection facilities, vehicles and equipment.

# 10. L22-095 - Natchitoches Parish, City of Natchitoches (DEQProject)

Not exceeding \$935,000 Utilities Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 0.95%, not exceeding 22 years, acquiring and constructing additions, extensions and improvements to combined waterworks plant and system, electric power and light plant and system and sewer utility system, including equipment and fixtures.

### 11. L22-091 - St. Tammany Parish, Lakeshore Villages Master Community Development District

Not exceeding \$11,000,000 Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 6%, not exceeding 30 years, (1) transportation improvements, including arterial and collector roadways and bridges, (2) potable water and sewerage improvements, (3) stormwater management ponds and pumping stations, drainage canals and subsurface stormwater collection system, (4) electrical distribution system, (5) recreational facilities, parks and green space, (6) related incidental costs (including assessment prepayments on transferred property) and (7) funding a reserve and/or capitalized interest, if required.

# 12. L22-093 - Winn Parish, City of Winnfield (LDH Project)

Not exceeding \$1,900,000 Taxable Excess Revenue Bonds, non-interest bearing, not exceeding 10 years, constructing and acquiring improvements, extensions and replacements to the drinking water system, including equipment, fixtures and accessories.

### Local Political Subdivisions - Refinancings

### 13. L22-097 - Jefferson & St. Tammany Parishes, Greater New Orleans Expressway Commission

(1) Not exceeding \$28,500,000 Refunding Bonds (Senior Lien Bonds, NSTSD), not exceeding 5%, mature no later than November 1, 2033, (a) refunding Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2013 and 2014, (b) funding any reserves if necessary; (2) Not exceeding \$99,000,000 Toll Revenue Subordinate Lien Refunding Bonds, not exceeding 5%, mature no later than November 1, 2047, (a) refunding Toll Revenue Subordinate Lien Bonds, Series 2017 (b) funding any reserves if necessary.

### 14. S22-020 - Orleans Parish, Ernest N. Morial - New Orleans Exhibition Hall Authority

Not exceeding \$47,500,000 Special Tax Refunding Bonds, not exceeding 5%, mature no later than July 15, 2027, (1) refunding all or a portion of Special Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2012 and Series 2014 and (2) funding a reserve fund, if necessary.

# State Agencies, Boards and Commissions

### 15. S22-015 - Louisiana Housing Corporation (Fairmont Towers Project)

Not exceeding \$15,000,000 Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds (Volume Cap), not exceeding 8%, not exceeding 40 years, acquisition, construction, rehabilitation and equipping of a 254 unit multifamily housing facility in Shreveport.

# 16. S22-016 - Louisiana Housing Corporation (St. Claude Gardens II Project)

Not exceeding \$4,500,000 Multifamily Housing Revenue Bonds (Volume Cap), not exceeding 8%, not exceeding 40 years, acquisition, construction, and equipping of a 39 unit multifamily housing facility in New Orleans.

# Political Subdivisions - Bonds

# 17. S22-013 - Louisiana Community Development Authority (St. Bernard Port, Harbor and Terminal District Project)

Not exceeding \$7,000,000 Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 5%, not exceeding 20 years, (1) port facilities and improvements and (2) funding a debt service reserve fund, if necessary.

# 18. S22-014 - Louisiana Community Development Authority (Town of St. Francisville Sewer Project)

Not exceeding \$5,250,000 Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 4%, not exceeding 14 years, (1) construct, acquire, extend, expand, improve, maintain, operate and decommission sewerage facilities, (2) acquiring immovable property, servitudes and equipment related thereto and (3) funding a reserve fund, if necessary.

# 19. S22-017 - Louisiana Community Development Authority (Jefferson Culture and Parks Project)

Not exceeding \$15,000,000 Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 5%, not exceeding 13 years, (1) acquiring, constructing, replacing, improving and maintaining capital improvements and (2) funding a reserve fund, if required.

# 20. S22-018 - Louisiana Public Facilities Authority (Lincoln Preparatory School Project)

Not exceeding \$15,000,000 Revenue Bonds, not exceeding 8%, not exceeding 40 years, (1) acquisition, construction, renovation and equipping of athletic facilities of the Lincoln Preparatory School, including a football field, baseball field, softball field, fieldhouse and ancillary facilities, (2) acquisition of a building to be used for pre-K and kindergarten classrooms, (3) funding a reserve fund and (4) paying capitalized interest.
