R S 42:1119 NEPOTISM as it relates to the appointed State Police Superintendent Kevin Reeves, whether *interim* or *permanent*, the provisions shall not prohibit the continued employment of Kaleb W. Reeves, a graduate of the State Police Academy Cadet Class #95, nor shall it be construed to hinder, alter, or in any way affect normal promotional advancements in public employment, provide that such commissioned officer shall not be in the *direct line of supervision* of another LSP employee if they are related pursuant to LSP Procedure Order 101 Organization Structure.”
