**OLD BUSINESS**

- A. A resolution ordering and calling a special election to be held in the Iberia Parish Levee, Hurricane and Conservation District, State of Louisiana, to authorize the levy of a special tax therein; making application to the State Bond Commission in connection therewith; and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

For discussion purposes the following is the language of the proposition to appear on the ballot:

Shall the Iberia Parish Levee, Hurricane and Conservation District (the "District"), levy a five (5) mills on all the property subject to taxation in the District (an estimated \$2,900,000 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of tax for an entire year), for a period of thirty (30) years, beginning with the year 2018 and ending 2047, to be dedicated solely for the purposes of construction, acquisition, maintenance, operation and extension and/or improvement of levees, hurricane/surge protection, and flood control within the District?

### **NEW BUSINESS**

A. Discuss and Consider a resolution authorizing the Chairman to sign a letter of intent and the Secretary Treasurer to sign the Self Certification of Financial Capability with the Army Corps of Engineers to undertake an investigation of flood risk management issues in Iberia Parish including the banks of Bayou Carlin and the City of Delcambre. (this is a 50/50 cost share process with the Levee District to meet its share with in kind services or assistance)
