A number of issues have arisen over the years relating to the transferability of distance learning coursework, dual enrollment coursework, and many other non-traditional formats. In light of our efforts as a Council to encourage transfer and to improve the overall transfer environment, I would like to ask the Council to consider the following policy language. "As a guiding principle, course content, not method of course delivery, should be the primary determining factor in the acceptance of credit in transfer between Louisiana's two- and four-year public colleges and universities."
