Mr. Keller explained the port participation in the Oyster Farming Program. A motion was made by Commissioner Besson, seconded by Commissioner Pizani and unanimously agreed to approve applying for an additional 25 acres for oyster farming. Mr. Keller and John Supan will scout out new areas for additional farming.
