December 18, 2025

The regular meeting of the Commercial Board was called to order by the Vice-Chairman, William J. Clouatre, on Thursday, December 18, 2025, at 9:30 a.m. at 600 North Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

Chairman Lee Mallett, Treasurer Brian Bordelon, and members Kym DiGiovanni, David Gallo, Curtis Joseph, and Christopher Stuart were absent. There being a quorum present, the regular order of business began.

Mr. Elliott Temple led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Hunter Farrar introduced himself as the hearing officer overseeing these proceedings and addressed the audience and board on the administrative procedures for hearings.

Mr. Lopez made a motion to accept the minutes of the November 19, 2025, and November 20, 2025, regular meetings. Mr. Temple seconded. The motion passed.

No public comment was received.

NEW BUSINESS

D. REQUEST FOR REHEARING:

1. **JON ANDERSEN AND ANDERSEN DESIGN + BUILD, LLC**, La. R.S. 37:2158(A)(18)
LSLBC Case 2025-1116-01

On motion by Mr. Temple, seconded by Mr. Tillage, and passed unanimously, the rehearing request was granted. Jon Andersen was present on behalf of JON ANDERSEN AND ANDERSEN DESIGN + BUILD, LLC, and was sworn in. Ms. Morgan gave a summary of the allegations. Mr. Andersen entered a plea of not guilty. Investigator Stephanie Belanger and Director of Investigations Joseph Anderson were called to the stand and were sworn in. Ms. Belanger reviewed the exhibit packet and provided testimony to the board. Mr. Landreneau entered the exhibit packet into the record, and it was admitted.

Hearing Officer Farrar questioned Mr. Andersen regarding a motion submitted by Mr. Andersen pertaining to LSLBC Exhibit 5, the Affidavit of Randy Farrell, Jr. Mr. Farrar denied Mr. Andersen's motion to limit the probative value of the affidavit and accepted the affidavit into evidence without further objection.

Ms. Belanger provided testimony to the board under examination by Mr. Landreneau and cross-examination by Mr. Andersen.

Randy Farrell, Jr. was called to the stand and sworn in. Mr. Farrell provided testimony to the board under examination by Mr. Landreneau and cross-examination by Mr. Andersen. The board questioned Mr. Farrell.

Mr. Andersen submitted documents into evidence marked Exhibits A through X and they were admitted with objection to relevance as to Exhibits A, P and X by Mr. Landreneau overruled by Mr. Farrar. Mr. Andersen provided testimony to the board and answered questions from Mr. Landreneau and the board. Mr. Andersen submitted a timeline to be entered into evidence as an exhibit. Mr. Landreneau objected to the relevance of the timeline, and the objection was sustained by Mr. Farrar. Mr. Andersen provided additional testimony with cross-examination by Mr. Landreneau and questions from the board.

On motion by Mr. Lambert, seconded by Mr. Temple, and passed unanimously, JON ANDERSEN and ANDERSEN DESIGN + BUILD, LLC, were found guilty.

On motion by Mr. Lopez, seconded by Mr. Temple, and passed unanimously, the board revoked all licenses, classifications, and the qualifying party status held by JON ANDERSEN and ANDERSEN DESIGN + BUILD, LLC.


Mr. Hassert and the board gave statements of appreciation for Mr. Courtney Fenet’s 24 years of service on the board at his last meeting.
