

STATE LICENSING BOARD FOR CONTRACTORS
RESIDENTIAL BUILDING COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

A Motion was made by Mr. Dugas and seconded by Ms. Wendel to give Watco Construction, Inc. 30 days to surrender their license. The Motion passed.

Ms. Fitch read the allegations against Ascension Pools, LLC and asked if a representative was present.

Dawn Ewen appeared on behalf of Ascension Pools and Ewen Pools, LLC and was sworn in.

Ms. Fitch asked if Ms. Ewen had proof of insurances.

Ms. Ewen stated she did have proof of insurance for Ewen Pools but did not have proof of insurance for Ascension Pools, LLC as she is surrendering her license.

A Motion was made by Ms. Wendel and seconded by Mr. Dugas to accept the surrendering of Ascension Pools, LLC.'s license.

Ms. Fitch asked if Ms. Ewen had proof of insurance for Ewen Pools. Ms. Ewen stated that she had previously sent that information to the Board.

A Motion was made by Mr. Dugas and was seconded by Ms. Wendel to reinstate Ewen Pools License.

Brandon Holley, Owner, appeared on behalf of Holly Builders, was sworn in, and admitted the allegations.

A Motion was made by Ms. Wendel and seconded by Mr. Ward to accept the plea. The Motion passed.

A Motion was made by Ms. Gibson and seconded by Mr. Dugas to fine Holley Builders, LLC. Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00) plus court cost. The Motion passed.

PLUMB-LEVEL-SQUARE OF BATON ROUGE, LLC (UNLICENSED)

ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING – Consider an alleged violation of LA R.S. 37:2167 (A) of the Contractors' Licensing Law by, **PLUMB-LEVEL-SQUARE OF BATON ROUGE, LLC**, Prairieville, Louisiana, in that you have/or are in the process of constructing residence(s) and/or performing home improvements in the amount of \$215,390.00, at but not limited to, 5849 Kellywood Oaks, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, without possessing a State Residential Building License.

Ms. Bobbie Hughes read the allegations against Plumb-Level-Square of Baton Rouge, LLC and asked if there was a representative present.

Chad Bourque, member of Plumb-Level-Square, LLC appeared, was sworn in, and admitted the allegations.

A Motion was made by Ms. Wendel and seconded by Mr. Ward to accept the plea. The Motion passed.

A Motion was made by Ms. Gibson and was seconded by Ms. Wendel to fine Plumb-Level-Square of Baton Rouge Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) plus court costs. The Motion Passed.

GEORGE P. BAXTER D/B/A BAXTER'S DESIGNER POOLS (UNLICENSED)

ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING – Consider an alleged violation of LA R.S. 37:2175.2 (A) of the Contractors' Licensing Law by, GEORGE P. BAXTER D/B/A BAXTER'S DESIGNER POOLS, Metairie, Louisiana, in that you have/or are performing home improvement contracting services in the amount of \$35,000.00, at but not limited to, 114 Good News Avenue, Belle Chasse, Louisiana without possessing a State Home Improvement Registration.

Ms. Bobbie Hughes read the allegations against George P. Baxter d/b/a Baxter's Designer Pools and informed the Board that this was Mr. Baxter's third appearance before the Board. Ms. Hughes asked if there was a representative present.

Mr. Gabrielle Mondino, attorney, appeared on behalf of George P. Baxter, was sworn in, and denied the allegations.

Mr. George P. Baxter was sworn in.

Ms. Angela Adolph called Ms. Mary Ann Sullivan, Investigator, to the podium.

Mr. Mary Ann Sullivan was sworn in and explained her findings.

Ms. Adolph reviewed the exhibit package with Ms. Sullivan. The exhibit package was entered in to record.

Mr. Mondino stated he had no objection to the exhibit package, but did have a different version of item three (3) and objected to the authenticity of item three (3).

A Motion was made by Mr. Ward and was seconded by Ms. Wendel to find George P. Baxter d/b/a Baxter's Designer Pools guilty with the recommendation of a maximum fine, Nine Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$9250.00), court cost, cease and desist. The Motion passed.

JOHNNY COLE (UNLICENSED)

Also, to consider an alleged violation of LA R.S. 37:2167 (A) of the Contractors' Licensing Law, in that you have or/are in the process of constructing new residences(s) and/or performing home improvements in the amount of \$95,400.00, at but not limited to, 6224 Tennyson Oaks Lane, Alexandria, Louisiana without possessing a State Residential Building License.

Ms. Bobbie Hughes read the allegations against Johnny Cole and asked if Mr. Cole was present.

Mr. Johnny Lee Cole appeared before the Board and was sworn in. Mr. Cole admitted the allegations.

A Motion was made by Mr. Ward and seconded by Ms. Wendel to accept the plea. The Motion passed.

Mr. William Collins, Inspector, was sworn in and explained the findings against Johnny Cole.

A Motion was made by Mr. Ward and seconded by Mr. Dugas to fine Mr. Johnny Cole One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) plus court cost and cease and desist. The Motion passed.

RODNEY COREY D/B/A FIVE STARR BUILDERS OF HOUSTON & WASKOM, TEXAS, (UNLICENSED)

ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING – Consider an alleged violation of LA R.S. 37:2175.2 (A) of the Contractors' Licensing Law by, RODNEY COREY D/B/A FIVE STARR BUILDERS OF HOUSTON & WASKOM, TEXAS, Marshall, Texas, in that you have/or are performing home improvement contracting services in the amount of \$68,850.00, at but not limited to, 4213 Sligo Road, Haughton, Louisiana without possessing a State Home Improvement Registration.

Ms. Bobbie Hughes read the allegations against Rodney Corey d/b/a Five Starr Builders of Houston & Waskom, Texas and asked if a representative was present.

Mr. Rodney Cory, owner of Five Starr Builders of Houston & Waskom Texas appeared and admitted the allegations.

A Motion was made by Ms. Wendel and seconded by Mr. Ward to accept the plea. The Motion passed.

Mr. Carl Bourque, Inspector, was sworn in and explained his findings.

Ms. Angela Adolph, attorney for the Board, explained she had been informed that the Attorney General had issued opinion 04-0325 which states, "that the definition of home improvement contracting under LA R.S. 37:2150.1 includes the construction of a new, free-standing structure not attached to a residence" on this matter.

A Motion was made by Ms. Wendel and seconded by Ms. Gibson to fine Five Starr Builders of Houston & Waskom Texas Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) plus court cost. The Motion passed.

HERBERT HANSON D/B/A HEYER-HANSON INSPECTIONS, INC (UNLICENSED)

ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING – Consider an alleged violation of LA R.S. 37:2175.2 (A) of the Contractors' Licensing Law by, HERBERT HANSON D/B/A HEYER-HANSON INSPECTIONS, INC., Abita Springs, Louisiana, in that you have/or are performing home improvement contracting services in the amount of \$20,675.00, at but not limited to, 117 D'Evereaux Drive, Slidell, Louisiana without possessing a State Home Improvement Registration.

Ms. Bobbie Hughes read the allegations against Herbert Hanson d/b/a Heyer-Hanson Inspectors, Inc. and asked if a representative was present.

Mr. Herbert Hanson appeared before the Board, was sworn in and admitted the allegations.

A Motion was made by Mr. Dugas and seconded by Mr. Ward to accept the plea. The Motion passed.

Mr. Mark Williamson, Inspector, appeared was sworn in and explained his findings.

A Motion was made by Mr. Ward and was seconded by Mr. Dugas to fine Herbert Hanson d/b/a Heyer-Hanson Inspections, Inc., Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) plus administrative costs. The fine of \$2,000.00 assessed will be waived providing license/registration is obtained within 90 days of the Hearing. The Motion passed.

Michael Hartford, Owner of Michael Hartford d/b/a Hartford Home Improvements, appeared, was sworn in, and admitted the allegations.

A Motion was made by Mr. Ward and was seconded by Ms. Wendel to accept the plea. The Motion passed.

A Motion was made by Ms. Gibson and was seconded by Mr. Dugas to fine Michael Hartford d/b/a Hartford Home Improvements Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) plus administrative costs. The fine of \$2,000.00 assessed will be waived providing license/registration is obtained within 90 days of the Hearing. The Motion passed.

A Motion was made by Ms. Wendel and was seconded by Mr. Ward to accept the plea. The Motion passed.

Mr. Mark Williamson, Inspector, appeared, was sworn in and explained his findings.

A Motion was made by Ms. Gibson and was seconded by Ms. Wendel to fine Sonics Dry Wall Systems Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00) plus court cost, cease and desist and 90 days to obtain a Home Improvement Registration. The fine of \$2,500.00 assessed will be waived providing license/registration is obtained within 90 days of the Hearing. The Motion passed. The Motion Passed.

Ms. Bobbie Hughes read the allegations against Russell Joyner d/b/a Joyner's Construction and asked if a representative was present.

Mr. Russell Joyner, Owner, appeared, was sworn in and admitted the allegations. Mr. Joyner stated he had applied for a Home Improvement Registration.
