II. Discuss/Adopt a Resolution for the Port of Iberia District to Engage GIS Engineering, LLC to Prepare and Submit an Application to the Louisiana Port Construction & Development Priority Program for Assistance in the Implementation of a Port Improvement Project Regarding Crosby Construction Services, Inc., Facility Expansion.

A letter dated February 28, 2020 from Crosby Construction Services was presented to the Board for review. Mr. Kevin Bordelon, Senior Vice President, stated in the Letter of Intent from Crosby Construction Services, Inc. that Crosby is requesting to re-negotiate their Lease Agreement with the Port of Iberia upon the completion of the expansion request submitted to the PORT on January 16, 2020. The general overview of the request indicates that Crosby Construction Services, Inc. has decided to execute a multi-faceted capital improvement project at its New Iberia Facility. The Project is meant to enhance Crosby's manufacturing capabilities by increasing usable yard space and parking, as well as increasing the number of fitters and welders that can operate in the fab shop. The schedule is expected to commence in June 2020, and the expected completion is July 2020. Mr. Malbrough reported to the Board details of the Project. Discussion ensued.

Crosby would like the Port to submit an Application to the Louisiana Port Construction & Development Priority Program in the amount of \$826,000.00 for assistance in the implementation of a Port Improvement Project regarding Crosby Construction Services, Inc. Facility Expansion.
