- Mrs. Joanna Durke stated that Diversified Materials is unable to pay at this time.
 Commissioner Roy A. Pontiff suggested charging Diversified Materials late fees.

- Mrs. Joanna Durke stated that Rigid Constructors balance will get paid within the next few days.

- III. Discuss Findings & Recommendations from the Policies & Procedures Committee Meeting Held on Friday, February 26, 2021.
 - (a) Discuss and Review Listing Agreement Between Max J. Derbes, Inc. and the Port of Iberia for Marketing Vacant Port Properties.
 - (b) Discuss Adding Future Parcels.
 - Commissioner Shane Walet presented the Board with a spreadsheet for an example per say if Seadrill & Turner Industries were to go through Max Derbes showing the various costs.
 - Mr. Ray Allain stated that they had made changes and one of the changes is that the commission is only payable to Max Derbes once the Port has been paid.
 - Commissioner Roy A. Pontiff stated that if the Port adds the .36% or .4% on top of the annual lease rate, then the Port would make the money back if the tenant would stay the full term.
 - Mr. Bryce French stated that they would do thorough reviews & evaluate the tenant's credit situation to make sure they are in a good financial situation to be able to carry the lease to term.
 - Commissioner Mark Dore' stated that the Port has a fixed 6% that they have been using, and should stay with the 6% and just modify if needed.

- Mr. Happy Davis with Max Derbes stated that the goal is to minimize the risk and maximize the return.
- Commissioner Patrick Broussard questioned the first sentence on the second page
 of the Listing Agreement and wanted to be sure that Mr. Craig Romero would still
 be involved with the negotiations. Mr. Bryce French of Max Derbes stated that the
 language simply means that the Port would not hire another brokerage firm. The
 decision is the Port's weather to accept the offer of the tenant or to reject it.
- Commissioner Shane Walet questioned that if the tenant is already there but wants to do improvements, how is the lease rate adjusted. Mr. Bryce French stated that if the tenant comes from Max Derbes & the Port makes improvements, Max Derbes will participate in the lease adjustments. If the tenant does their own improvements, then Max Derbes does not participate.
- Commissioner Shane Walet questioned if the Listing Agreement would need to be signed every time a property is added to the Addendum. Mr. Bryce French of Max Derbes stated that the Listing Agreement would get signed once. The Addendum is just to have the listing of the properties the Port wants Max Derbes to market.
- Commissioner Shane Walet questioned the turnaround time for Max Derbes to put a property on the market. Mr. Bryce French stated that they will have someone come out to the Port and take aerial video and photography of the property to put together to show prospective tenants. Mr. Bryce French stated that it would take approximately Three (3) weeks to have something that is comfortable for both Max Derbes and the Port.
- Mr. Bryce French stated that there is a tremendous amount of momentum right now for the Port to make a marketing statement with the Dredging Project and the Turner Industries Announcement Ceremony.

- IV. Report from Mrs. Carmel Breaux, President, Norris Insurance Consultants, Inc., Regarding the Port of Iberia District's, 2021 Annual Insurance Renewals and Request for Proposals:
 - (1) (May 12, 2021 Renewal):
 General Liability, Automobile Liability and Physical Damage, Umbrella
 Liability, Public Official Errors & Omissions Liability, Crime, Boiler &
 Machinery, Inland Marine, Equipment Floater and Building & Contents.

- Mrs. Carmel Breaux presented the Board with Two (2) spreadsheets; Workers Compensation Insurance and Flood Insurance.
- Mrs. Carmel Breaux stated that she is in the process of doing RFP's on General Liability, Liability for Auto, Property, and Public Officials' renewal. The quotes are due back on April 6, 2021. Mrs. Carmel Breaux stated that she has Four (4) agents involved in this process. She stated that she feels like she will receive from more than just the Port's current agent. She also stated that on April 6th she will know what the numbers will look like & will come present to the Board in April.
- Mrs. Carmel Breaux stated that the Workers Compensation premium is \$3,614.00. This is about a \$140 decrease from last year.
- Mrs. Carmel Breaux recommended that the Port authorize the renewal for Workers Compensation with LWCC for the \$3,614.00.

A motion was made by Commissioner Elbridge "Smitty" Smith, III., seconded by Commissioner Simieon d. Theodile to approve and authorize the renewal of the Port's Workers Compensation Insurance with LWCC for 2021 with the annual premium of \$3,614.00.

- Mrs. Carmel Breaux stated that there is a total of 25 flood policies.
- Mrs. Carmel Breaux stated that she is recommending to renew the April 1, 2021 policies for the total of \$60,341.00.
- Mrs. Carmel Breaux stated that the premium for 2020 was \$59,024.00. This is about a \$1,300.00 increase.
- Mrs. Carmel Breaux discussed the Column 2021 Premium with increased deductibles. Mrs. Carmel stated that she asked Brown & Brown for a quote on increasing the deductible on properties that do not carry the maximum \$500,000.00 limit on building coverage to \$5,000.00. If the building had maximum 500,000 coverage to quote increasing the deductible to 50,000.00.
- Mrs. Carmel Breaux stated that if the Board would increase the deductibles like she has presented then the premium would drop to \$51,362.00.
- Mrs. Carmel stated that it does not make sense to increase the deductible on all the buildings where they carry on to the 5,000. Mrs. Carmel Breaux gave an example using the Administrative Office. Mrs. Carmel Breaux stated that by increasing the deductible to 5,000, comparing the premium with the deductible of 1,250, the Port is only saving about \$600.00.

• Mrs. Carmel Breaux stated that what does make sense is that the Port has Two Buildings; one Superior Building & one Chart Building, that have the maximum building coverage at 500,000, increasing these to the 50,000 deductibles being it is a significant savings. Mrs. Carmel also stated that if the Port would renew the policies as is and just increase the deductible on those two buildings the premium for this renewal would be \$52,809. This is Mrs. Carmel Breaux's recommendation for the Port to do.
