The Special meeting of the Port of Iberia District Board of Commissioners was called to order by Commissioner Mark Dore', Board President, at the Port of Iberia Administrative Office, on Wednesday, December 23, 2020, at 12:00 P.M.

Thus, with a quorum being acknowledged, Commissioner Elbridge "Smitty" Smith, III recited the opening prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

I. Discuss/Consider approval of payment for land rights associated with the required workspace as per agreement between Sterling Sugars et al, McIhenny Co., and Durice Leleux, Jr. and Boardwalk Pipeline Co. and Shell Pipeline in order that they are able to conduct their pipeline lowering necessary for AGMAC Phase I Dredging Project (Commercial Canal) and DNR and U. S. Army Corps of Engineers Permit requirements; and furthermore, Discuss/Consider authorizing the Board President to execute any necessary agreements and/or documentation regarding same.

A motion was made by Commissioner Elbridge "Smitty" Smith, III, seconded by Commissioner Simieon d. Theodile to approve and authorize the payment for land rights associated with the required workspace as per Temporary Workspace and Access Agreement between Sterling Sugars, L.L.C, Gonsoulin Farms, L.L.C, and the Port of Iberia; motion further authorizes the Board President to execute the Temporary Workspace and Access Agreement as presented.

II. Discuss/Consider Letter Dated December 17, 2020 From Parker Drilling Regarding Their Lease on Tract F-2 (10.00 acres) Located at the Port Millennium Expansion Phase I Property Site.

Commissioner Shane Walet recommended allowing Parker Drilling the same deferment as Crosby received recently. They would defer the lease payment for January thru June and only bill for July thru December 2021. If Parker Drilling was to renew their lease for 2022 they would then pay January thru June back 50% in 2022 and 50% in 2023. Parker Drilling is currently in a 5 year renewal option ending on December 31, 2021. They have Three (3) more 5 year renewal options available. Commissioner Mark Dore' stated that it's not a forgivness but a delay of payment.

A motion was made by Commissioner Patrick Broussard, seconded by Commissioner Danny J. David, Sr. to approve Parker Drilling lease payment be deferred for Six (6) months commencing on January 1, 2021 thru June 30, 2021 with the total amount of deferral being paid back to the Port of Iberia with 50% of the amount due in 2022 and the other 50% of the amount in 2023.
