The Board of Commissioners for the Fifth Louisiana Levee District met in regular session on Wednesday, April 9, 2025, at the Levee Board Office, 102 Burnside Drive, Tallulah, LA at 9:00 a.m. President Reynold Minsky called the meeting to order. Commissioners Kennedy, Hill, Brown, Hardwick, and Hiner answered rollcall.

On motion by Commissioner Brown, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Hill, the Board voted to ratify all Board actions taken in the February 12, 2025, meeting. No public comments were offered.

After no public comments were made, the Board approved minutes from the February meeting on a motion by Commissioner Hill, second by Commissioner Hardwick.

Commissioners reviewed and approved claims submitted for February and March on motion by Commissioner Hill, second by Commissioner Hiner, after hearing no public comments. Commissioners reviewed financial statements for the same period.

On motion by Commissioner Hill, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Kennedy, Board approved resolution adopting FY 2025-2026 Budget Amendments. No public comments were offered.

Board heard comments from landowner Samuel Hogue concerning a ditch dug adjacent to a ring levee in Tensas Parish. Board advised that he should contact the Police Jury. No action was taken.

There being no new business to consider, the meeting was adjourned on motion by Commissioner Hill, second by Commissioner Hiner
