## Fifth Louisiana Levee District June 10, 2020

The Board of Commissioners for the Fifth Louisiana Levee District met in regular session on Wednesday, June 10, 2020, at the Levee Board Office, 102 Burnside Drive, Tallulah, LA at 9:00 a.m. President Reynold Minsky called the meeting to order.
