After hearing no public comments, on motion by Commissioner Maxwell 2nd by Commissioner Hill, Board approved resolution giving USACE, Vicksburg District, rights-ofentry, including ingress and egress, in Tensas Parish for a two-year period beginning October 16, 2017, in conjunction with FC/MR&T, WBMRL, Seepage Control, Item 401-R, Point Pleasant – Yucatan, Tensas Parish, Louisiana.

Board discussed letter from Mr. Biedenharn concerning replacement power on property impacted by Item 416-R. No action taken.
