## MINUTES OF THE GRAND ISLE INDEPENDENT LEVEE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING FRIDAY, OCTOBER 3, 2014 11:00 A.M.

The Grand Isle Independent Levee District met on Friday, October 3, 2014, at 11:00 a.m. in a regular meeting at the Grand Isle Multiplex Center with the following commissioners:

Present: 3 Commissioners – David Camardelle, Kelly Besson, Sr. and Arthur Bellanger

Absent: 0

President Camardelle called the meeting to order and then led with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a prayer.

A motion was made by Commissioner Besson, seconded by Commissioner Bellanger and unanimously agreed to approve the minutes of the meeting held on September 9, 2014 as read.

Mr. Dustin Malbrough from CB & I gave the following report: 1. He attended a meeting with NEFS on the Fifi Island Rock and Restoration Project and agreed upon 2 gaps to allow tidal flow through the rock dike. 2. Additional breakwater by foot of Bridge has been designed and permit modified and will submit to agencies for permit. 3. The engineers will be working on Capital Outlay request for the coming year which will include design for the Fifi Island segmented rock breakwaters.

President Camardelle stated that Senator Landrieu, Senator Vitter and Representative Scalise are working with the Corps and State agencies to assist the levee district to build more levees and segmented rock breakwaters. Senator Alario and Representative Gisclair are working with state agencies assisting with Capital Outlay Projects. Jefferson Parish Officials are always ready to assist Grand Isle when needed.

President Camardelle thanked the board members, town officials, port commissioners, Jefferson Parish, State agencies such as CPRA, Governor's Office for helping with more rock breakwaters and dredging of Bayou Rigaud to build up Fifi Island.

Joint motion by the commissioner to authorize the President to send a letter requesting that Lake Ponchatrain Levee District donate the bull dozer that was used to help with the seaweed that was on the beach earlier this year.

A motion was made by Commissioner Besson, seconded by Commissioner Bellanger and unanimously agreed to approve the expenses associated with the Annual Association of Levee Board Meetings in New Orleans in December.

A motion was made by Commissioner Besson, seconded by Commissioner Bellanger and unanimously agreed to adjourn the meeting at 11:35 a.m.
