The Finance, Administration, Legal and Public Information (FALPI) Committee of the SLFPA-W met on Tuesday, September 8, 2020, with the following members present in person: Mr. Gauthé, Chairman and Mr. Burke.

Mr. Gauthé called the meeting to order in the Commissioners' meeting room at the SLFPA-W Office, 7001 River Road, Marrero, Louisiana at approximately 3:52 P.M.

It was moved by Mr. Gauthé and seconded by Mr. Burke to approve the agenda as presented.

There were no public comments.

It was moved by Mr. Gauthé and seconded by Mr. Burke to approve the minutes from the previous meeting dated August 11, 2020.

Mr. Bosch presented the check register for SLFPA–W, West Jefferson Levee District and Algiers Levee District. It was moved by Mr. Gauthé and seconded by Mr. Burke to recommend the check register for approval by the Board.

Mr. Bosch provided an update on the current budget. He will continue to update the Committee.

Mr. Bosch updated the Committee on the financial statements for SLFPA-W, West Jefferson Levee District and Algiers Levee District.

Mr. Cali briefed the Committee on the proposed in kind replacement purchases of three John Deere R15 cutting decks at a cost of \$21,185.01 each, and three John Deere 5115M tractors at a cost of \$62,613.82 each. The FALPI Committee concurred with the purchases. The proposals will go to the September 29, 2020 Regular Board Meeting for approval.

Mr. Cali briefed the Committee on the Authorization for Expenditure (AFE) process. The current Authorization for Expenditure (AFE) process will continue.

Mr. Burke and Mr. Cali led a discussion on the West Closure Complex (WCC) server project. Mr. Burke requested Mr. Cali obtain a written proposal for the cost of the WCC server.

Mr. Cali provided a Director's report of his activities for the month of September and informed the Committee of pending issues. Mr. Burke requested Mr. Cali contact Jefferson Parish in regard to the continuation of the all-weather access road from Robinson Avenue to Harvey Park.
