## SOUTHEAST LOUISIANA FLOOD PROTECTION AUTHORITY – WEST (SLFPA-W) Technical, Operations and Maintenance Committee Meeting Tuesday, November 13, 2018

The Technical, Operations and Maintenance (TOM) Committee of the SLFPA-W met on Tuesday, November 13, 2018, with the following members present: Dr. Valent, chairman, Mr. Thomas and Mr. Wilkinson.

Dr. Valent called the meeting to order in the Commissioners' meeting room at the SLFPA-W Office, 7001 River Road, Marrero, Louisiana at approximately 1:30 P.M.

It was moved by Mr. Thomas, seconded by Mr. Wilkinson and unanimously approved by the Committee to approve the agenda as presented.
