Regular Meeting Minutes

October 15, 2025

Board President, Anthony Alford called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, October 15, 2025.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Alford, Daisy, Moore, Chauvin, Davis, Henry, Walker. There were two Commissioners recorded as absent, Tenner Cenac and Arlanda Smith.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Daisy, to approve the meeting minutes dated October 1, 2025. The motion passed without objection. \

Under Public Comments, Tyler Ortogo with Natrx spoke about the cajun coral at Reach K.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux gave an update on the closures and maintenance on floodgates. He also spoke about J1/J2, Aragon Pit, and Reach I

Trey Middleton gave updates on the HNC lock, Reach A, Reach H-3, Reach I, Reach J-2, Reach K and Reach L.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Operating and Engineering Invoices. Motion by Commissioner Davis, seconded by Commissioner Walker. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Financial Report FME 31 September 2025. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, seconded by Commissioner Walker. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of the Resolution 25-028 authorizing to execute an IGA with CPRA for engineering and designing of the Eastern Terrebonne Restoration Project (Project # TE-0186). This will be a CPRA entrusted project. It will be 94 miles long, traveling from Loss Lake to Golden Meadow. Motion by Commissioner Moore, seconded by Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of the Program Management Contract with Delta Coast Consultants for the Eastern Terrebonne Restoration Project that is subject to CPRA approval. Motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of the engineering and design contract with GIS Engineering for the Eastern Terrebonne Restoration Project that is subject to CPRA approval. Motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of Resolution No. 25-029 to appropriate a permanent levee servitude for Reach I of the Morganza to the Gulf Hurricane Protection Project. Motion by Commissioner Moore, seconded by Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of Resolution No. 25-030 to grant Substantial Completion to Onshore Materials for the Lower Dularge East Levee Emergency Rehabilitation. Motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the recommendation of award to Lirette Dirt Services for the Morganza to the Gulf Hurricane Protection Levee for the Upper Reach I Rehabilitation Project in the amount of \$971,231.50. Motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Diasy. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the recommendation of final acceptance to Justin J. Reeves LLC for the Reach A Emergency Levee Segment 1 Project. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, seconded by Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

There was no Executive Session.

Under Planning & Projects Committee Matters, Jay Duplantis with All South Consulting provided updates on the following projects: Reach K Rehabilitation.

Philip Chauvin with T. Baker Smith gave updates on the following projects: General Services Agreement and Reach I Phase 2 Improvements.

David Boudreaux with Delta Coast Consultants gave updates with his October Monthly Status Report.

David Boudreaux asked for the approval of Change Order No. 1 for Sealevel Construction in the amount of \$60,000.00 for the Reach L Rehabilitation Project to extend the amount of grading work to complete the project. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, seconded by Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

There being no further business to come before the board, it was moved by Commissioner Moore, with a second by Commissioner Chauvin, to adjourn the October 15, 2025, board meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at 7:12 P.M. The motion passed without objection.
