Regular Meeting Minutes

April 15, 2026

Board President, Anthony Alford called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, April 15, 2026.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Alford, Walker, Moore, Chauvin, Davis, and Henry There were three Commissioners recorded as absent, Tenner Cenac, Arlanda Smith, and Jeff Daisy.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin, to approve the meeting minutes dated April 1, 2026. The motion passed without objection.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux gave updates on the routine maintenance in areas He spoke about the Bayou Lacache issues, they will be pulling the pump in two to four weeks.

Trey Middleton gave updates and an end of the year presentation on the HNC lock, Reach A, Reach H-3, Reach I, Reach J-2, Reach K, CPRA Projects, Eastern Terrebonne Restoration Project, Wine Island Restoration Project and Reach L. Trey also spoke on the future purchase of a hydro seeder.

Chairman Moore asked for the approval of Resolution 26-006 for adopting the 2026 Millage Rate. Motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Davis. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Operating and Engineering Invoices. Motion by Commissioner Davis, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Financial Report FME 31 MARCH 2026. Motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Pernell Pellegrin gave a final overview of the 2025 Audit Report.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of Amendment No. 9 to the program manager services for Delta Coast Consultants Program Manager Contractor for the remainder of the fiscal year. Motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

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Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the possible action to enter into Agreement with Apache to access its lands to perform topographic and hydrographic investigations in connection with the Eastern Terrebonne Restoration Project. Motion by Commissioner Moore, seconded by Commissioner Walker. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of Resolution 26-007 to support the CPRA Annual Plan. Motion by Commissioner Moore, seconded by Commissioner Walker. The motion passed without objection.

There was no Executive Session.

Under Planning & Projects Committee Matters, Jay Duplantis with All South Consulting provided updates on the following projects: Reach K Water Structures, Reach K Rehabilitation, and the J-1 Levee Improvement Project.

Philip Chauvin with T. Baker Smith gave updates on the following projects: General Services Agreement and Reach I Phase 2 Improvements. He also stated that the aggregate bid was coming to an end.

Kevin Dezarn with GIS Engineering gave an update on the Bush Canal Floodgate Maintenance Dry Dock Project

Mr. Dezarn asked for the approval of Change Order No. 3 for Rigid Constructors to add 46 contract days to account for adverse weather. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Seconded by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

David Boudreaux with Delta Coast Consultants gave updates with his April Monthly Status Report. He spoke about Upper Reach I to a plus 15 and how segment 1 was complete.

There being no further business to come before the board, it was moved by Commissioner Moore, with a second by Commissioner Chauvin, to adjourn the April 15, 2026, board meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at 6:36 P.M. The motion passed without objection.
