Regular Meeting Minutes

August 5, 2026

Board President, Anthony Alford, called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, August 5, 2026.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Chauvin, Walker, Davis, Henry, Moore, and Alford. There were three Commissioners recorded as absent, Tenner Cenac, Arlanda Smith and Jeff Daisy.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Chuavin, seconded by Commissioner Walker, to approve the meeting minutes dated July 15, 2026. The motion passed without objection.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux gave updates on the damage to Bayou Terrebonne. He also spoke about the in-housework on J-2.

Trey Middleton gave updates on Reach H2/H3, Upper Reach I, and Upper Reach K.

Under Finance Committee Matters, Daniel Walker asked the board to approve the APTIM invoice #753028 in the amount of \$451,429.75. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Second by Commissioner Davis. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Walker asked the board to approve the Sealevel invoice #23105-025 in the amount of \$4,293,542.04. Motion by Commissioner Henry, Second by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Walker asked the board to approve Operating and Engineering invoices. Motion by Commissioner Henry, Second by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Under Executive Directors Report, Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of the Intergovernmental Agreement between TLCD and Terrebonne Parish Sheriff's Office for Security Patrol and Storm Assistance. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Second by Commissioner Walker. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the authorization to advertise for the new office facility. Motion by Commissioner Henry, Second by Commissioner Walker. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the recommendation of Award for the Reach A Minors Canal Access Road to Onshore Materials in the amount of \$7,994,500.00. This is contingent upon legal program management and the IGA with CPRA. Motion by Commissioner Henry, Second by Commissioner Davis. The motion passed without objection.

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Mrs. Hidalgo did not have any announcements.

There was no Executive Session.

Under Planning & Projects Committee Matters, Nicole O'Dell provided updates on the following project: HNC Lock Complex. She gave updates on the cofferdams, braced lock wall piles, marsh creation areas, and the operations area.

Mrs. O Dell asked for the approval of Change Order No. 11 to Sealevel Construction for the HNC Lock Complex in the amount of \$558,520.00 for the work related to the GSSG cofferdam rip rap obstruction exploration and removal. Motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Henry.

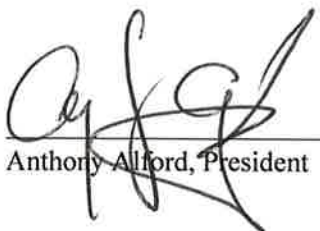
Kevin Dezarn with GIS Engineering gave updates on the following projects: Bayou Black Emergency Levee Repairs Project – A1F Permit Project, Reach B Levee Lift Project, Reach H2/H3 Levee Lift to EL. 15' Project (H3 is complete), Reach A Levee, Wine Island Restoration Project and the Bush Canal Floodgate Maintenance Project. The Bush Canal Floodgate Maintenance Project is substantially complete. Rigid constructors will also have a meeting on 7/16 to speak about the damage to Bayou Terrebonne.

Neil Angelette with Angelette Design and gave an update on the Reach L Pipeline. The project is in the clear lien period. He updated on the Reach L (Apache Farm) Interim Levee Lift to +12'.

Ben Rhodes with Delta Coast Consultants asked for the approval of Amendment No. 18 to the Engineering Service Contract between APTIM and TLCD in the amount of \$5,039,389.00 for additional services to be performed by Engineer for Construction Administration Phase 2. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Second by Commissioner Walker. The motion passed without objection.

Under the President's Report, there was nothing to report.

There being no further business to come before the board, it was moved by Commissioner Henry, with a second by Commissioner Chauvin, to adjourn the August 5, 2026, board meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at 6:34 P.M. The motion passed without objection.
