Regular Meeting Minutes

February 18, 2026

Board President, Anthony Alford called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, February 18, 2026.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Alford, Moore, Chauvin, Davis, Daisy, Henry, Walker. There were two Commissioners recorded as absent, Tenner Cenac and Arlanda Smith.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin, to approve the meeting minutes dated February 4, 2026. The motion passed without objection.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux was absent.

Trey Middleton gave updates and an end of the year presentation on the HNC lock, Reach A, Reach H-3, Reach I, Reach J-2, Reach K, CPRA Projects, Eastern Terrebonne Restoration Project, Wine Island Restoration Project and Reach L.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Operating and Engineering Invoices. Motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Financial Report FME 31 January 2026. Motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the Authorization to enter an IGA for O&M of the Bayou Chene Flood Control Structure. The TLCD portion cost would be \$100,00.00. Motion by Commissioner Davis, seconded by Commissioner Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hildago asked for the Authorization to advertise quotes for the Recoating of the Bayou Grand Caillou Barge Gate. Motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hildago asked for the Authorization to advertise the Indefinite Embankment Supply and Delivery Contracts to Reach J and K Levees. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, seconded by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hildago asked for the execution of Encroachment Agreement with Columbia Guld Transmission, LLC for the Upper Reach I Levee Rehabilitation Project. Motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hildago asked for the approval of Resolution 26-001 to grant Final Acceptance to Low Land Construction for the Indefinite Embankment Supply to the Reach J/2-J/3 (Reach K) Levee Segments. Motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Moore. The motion passed without objection.

There was no Executive Session.

Under Planning & Projects Committee Matters, Jay Duplantis with All South Consulting provided updates on the following projects: Reach K Water Structures.

Philip Chauvin with T. Baker Smith gave updates on the following projects: General Services Agreement and Reach I Phase 2 Improvements.

Mr. Chauvin asked for the approval for Change Order No. 9 for Sealevel Construction for the HNC Lock Complex Project in the amount of \$2,196,942.94 due to the timber spacing adjustment for the guidewalls. Motion by Commissioner Moore, seconded by Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Mitch Marmande with Delta Coast Consultants gave updates with his February Monthly Status Report. He spoke about Upper Reach I and pipeline relocations from the Core.

Mr. Marmande asked for the approval of Change Order No. 1 for Lirette Dirt Services for the Upper Reach I Levee in the amount of \$1,266,250.00 to increase material to the southern segment. Motion by Commissioner Moore, seconded by Commissioner Henry. The motion was passed without objection.

There being no further business to come before the board, it was moved by Commissioner Moore, with a second by Commissioner Chauvin, to adjourn the February 18, 2026, board meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at 6:37 P.M. The motion passed without objection.
