Regular Meeting Minutes

February 4, 2026

Finance Chairman, Jack Moore, called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, February 4, 2026.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Moore, Chauvin, Smith, Davis, Daisy, Henry, Alford, Cenac. There was one Commissioners recorded as absent, Daniel Walker.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Daisy, to approve the meeting minutes dated January 21, 2026. The motion passed without objection.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux gave an update on the closures and maintenance on floodgates. He had no major updates .

Trey Middleton had no updates to give. He asked for the approval of a quote from W&O Supply in the amount of \$13,578.64 for the Bush Canal 4'' and 6'' valve replacements. Motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Davis.

Under Finance Committee Matters, Jack Moore asked the board to approve the APTIM invoice #702025 in the amount of \$323,237.75. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Second by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Sealevel invoice #23105-019 in the amount of \$3,577,823.33. Motion by Commissioner Henry, Second by Commissioner Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve Operating and Engineering invoices. Motion by Commissioner Davis, Second by Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Under Executive Directors Report, Mrs. Hidalgo asked for approval of the Final Balancing Change Order No. 12 for Onshore Materials for the Reach J-3 Rehabilitation in the amount of \$45,252.80. Motion by Commissioner Henry, second by Moore. The motion passed without objection.

There was no Executive Session.

Under Planning & Projects Committee Matters, Nicole O'Dell provided updates on the following project: HNC Lock Complex. The dredge is complete and there are no changes to the operations area.

Kevin Dezarn with GIS Engineering gave updates on the following projects: Bayou Black Emergency Levee Repairs Project – ATF Permit Project, Reach B Levee Lift Project, Reach H2/H3 Levee Lift to EL. 15' Project, Reach A Levee, Wine Island Restoration Project and the Bush Canal Floodgate Maintenance Project.

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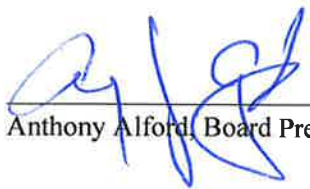
Kevin Dezarn asked for the approval of Change Order No. 1 for Bush Canal Floodgate in the amount of \$11,000.00 for the fabrication of a new locking pin due to the damage. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, seconded by Commissioner Cenac.

Neil Angelette with Angelette Designs gave an update on the Reach L Pipeline. The access is bridge is done. They have an estimate date of completion in spring.

Neil Angelette asked for the approval of Change Order No. 3 for Sealevel Construction for the Reach L Pipeline Floodwall for additional weather days from June through December 2025.

Under the President's Report, there was nothing to report.

There being no further business to come before the board, it was moved by Commissioner Henry, with a second by Commissioner Chauvin, to adjourn February 4, 2026, board meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at 6:19 P.M. The motion passed without objection.
