Regular Meeting Minutes

July 1, 2026

Board President, Anthony Alford, called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, July 1, 2026.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Chauvin, Walker, Davis, Henry, Moore, and Alford. There were three Commissioners recorded as absent, Tenner Cenac, Arlanda Smith and Jeff Daisy.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Chuavin, seconded by Commissioner Walker, to approve the meeting minutes dated June 17, 2026. The motion passed without objection.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux gave updates on the closing of the floodgates with Tropical Storm Arthur. A couple of the floodgates had minor issues which were addressed. He also spoke about the in-housework on J-2.

Trey Middleton gave updates on Reach H2/H3, Upper Reach I, PAC West levee that we are assisting the LWDF with, and Upper Reach K.

Under Finance Committee Matters, Jack Moore asked the board to approve the APTIM invoice #750109 in the amount of \$391,523.50. Motion by Commissioner Henry, Second by Commissioner Davis. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Sealevel invoice #23105-024 in the amount of \$9,354,823.87. Motion by Commissioner Henry, Second by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve Operating and Engineering invoices. Motion by Commissioner Davis, Second by Commissioner Walker. The motion passed without objection.

Under Executive Directors Report, Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of Resolution 26-009 to grant Substantial Completion to Allied Shipyard for the Bush Canal Floodgate Maintenance Dry Dock Project. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Second by Commissioner Walker. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of Resolution 26-010 to grant Substantial Completion to Sealevel Construction for the transportation of the Bush Canal Floodgate Maintenance Dry Dock Project. Motion by Commissioner Davis, Second by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of Resolution 26-011 declaring a state of emergency concerning vulnerabilities in the MTG Hurricane Protection System revealed by tropical weather events and Tropical Storm Arthur. Motion by Commissioner Walker, Second by Commissioner Moore. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the authorization to advertise the Reach A Emergency Project. Motion by Commissioner Davis, Seconded by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo spoke about the new office building update. TLCD is projected to go to bid by the end of the year. She spoke about the TLCD Hurricane Summit Meeting with employees, Engineers and Program Managers.

There was no Executive Session.

Under Planning & Projects Committee Matters, Nicole O'Dell provided updates on the following project: HNC Lock Complex. She gave updates on the cofferdams, braced lock wall piles, marsh creation areas, and the operations area.

Kevin Dezarn with GIS Engineering gave updates on the following projects: Bayou Black Emergency Levee Repairs Project – ATF Permit Project, Reach B Levee Lift Project, Reach H2/H3 Levee Lift to EL. 15' Project (H3 is complete), Reach A Levee, Wine Island Restoration Project and the Bush Canal Floodgate Maintenance Project. The Bush Canal Floodgate Maintenance Project is substantially complete.

Mitch Marmande with Delta Coast Consultants stepped in for Neil Angelette and gave an update on the Reach L Pipeline. The project is in the clear lien period. He updated on the Reach L (Apache Farm) Interim Levee Lift to +12'.

Corbin Hebert with Delta Coast Consultants asked for the approval of Change Order No. 1 to Lirette Dirt Service for the TLCD Yearly Levee Maintenance and Rehab Contract for the Reach K Levee Segment for the purpose of including certain provisions and clauses required by FEMA. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Second by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Corbin Hebert with Delta Coast Consultants asked for the approval of Change Order No. 1 Norris and Boudreaux for the TLCD Annual Levee Maintenance and Rehabilitation Contract for the purpose of including certain provisions and clauses required by FEMA. Motion by Commissioner Walker, Second by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Under the President's Report, there was nothing to report.

There being no further business to come before the board, it was moved by Commissioner Walker, with a second by Commissioner Cenac, to adjourn the July 1, 2026, board meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at 6:34 P.M. The motion passed without objection.
