Regular Meeting Minutes

July 15, 2026



Board President, Anthony Alford, called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, July 15, 2026.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Chauvin, Smith, Daisy, Henry, Moore, and Alford. There were three Commissioners recorded as absent, Tenner Cenac, Daniel Walker, and Dan Davis..

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Chuavin, seconded by Commissioner Walker, to approve the meeting minutes dated July 1, 2026. The motion passed without objection.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux gave updates on the maintenance of the floodgates following Tropical Storm Arthur. A couple of the floodgates had minor issues which were addressed. He also spoke about the in-housework on J-2 and the G2-B Culvert Damage.

Trey Middleton gave updates on the HNC Lock Complex as well as the future of Minors Canal and GIWW.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Operating and Engineering Invoices. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, seconded by Commissioner Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Financial Report FME 31 MAY 2026. Motion by Commissioner Daisy, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of the Final Balancing Change Order No. 4 for Allied Shipyard in the amount of (\$93,150.00) for the Bush Canal Barge Gate Maintenance Dry Dock Project to provide credit to the contract. Motion by Commissioner Moore, seconded by Commissioner Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of the Final Balancing Change Order No. 1 for Sealevel Construction in the amount of \$93,150.00 for the Bush Canal Barge Gate Transportation to repair the swing arm and relocate the locking pins during reinstallation. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, seconded by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for possible action to amend the All South Consulting Engineering Agreement for Lower Dularge. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, seconded by Commissioner Moore. The motion passed without objection.

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Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the possible action to amend Resolution 25-034 appropriating a permanent levee servitude for Reach F of the Morganza to the Guld Hurricane Protection System. Motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo spoke about the new TLCD office building process of going out to bid in August.

There was no Executive Session

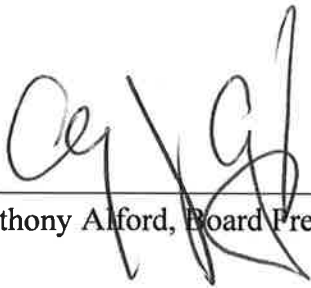
Under Planning & Projects Committee Matters, Jay Duplantis with All South Consulting provided updates on the following projects: Reach K Water Structures, Reach K Rehabilitation, and the J-1 Levee Improvement Project.

Philip Chauvin with T. Baker Smith gave updates on the following projects: General Services Agreement using the concrete mats as needed, Reach I Phase 2 Improvements and the TLCD Boudreaux Canal Sector Floodgate 10 Year Maintenance Contract.

Ben Rhodes with Delta Coast Consultants gave updates with his Monthly Status Report. He spoke about Upper Reach I, Reach K, Reach J, and the future EOC/Office building.

Ben Rhodes asked for the approval of Change Order No. 4 for Rigid Constructors for the Reach H2/H3 Levee Improvements Lift to +15' to add twenty-three (23) contract days to the contract to account for adverse weather. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, seconded by Commissioner Moore. The motion passed without objection.

There being no further business to come before the board, it was moved by Commissioner Chauvin, with a second by Commissioner Moore, to adjourn the July 15, 2026, board meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at 6:21 P.M. The motion passed without objection.
