Regular Meeting Minutes

June 17, 2026

Board President called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, June 17, 2026.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Moore, Chauvin, Davis, Cenac, Smith and Henry. There were two Commissioners recorded as absent, Jeff Daisy and Daniel Walker.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin, to approve the meeting minutes dated June 3, 2026. The motion passed without objection.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux gave updates on the routine maintenance in areas. He spoke about the closures of the flood gates due to Tropical Storm Arthur coming.

Trey Middleton had no updates at this meeting.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Operating and Engineering Invoices. Motion by Commissioner Davis, seconded by Commissioner Cenac. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Financial Report FME 31 MAY 2026. Motion by Commissioner Cenac, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

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Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of Resolution 26-008 to grant substantial completion to Sealevel Construction for the Floodwall Structure for Reach L Pipeline Crossings. Motion by Commissioner Moore, seconded by Commissioner Davis. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo spoke about the new TLCD office building process. She also spoke about the upcoming tour with LSU students, the hurricane prep meeting with the TLCD office personnel, and her recent trip to Vicksburg to see the GIWW model.

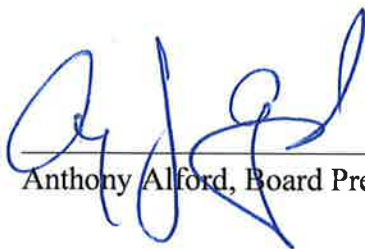
There was no Executive Session
